

HIGHWAYS ACT 1959 - Section 34 (6)

I, DEREK NORMAN EDMUNDSON Company Secretary for and on behalf of  
THE BOOTS COMPANY LIMITED whose Registered Office is at Nottingham  
NG2 3AA the owner of land and premises known as the Thurgarton Estate  
situate in the Parish of Thurgarton in the County of Nottingham and edged  
red on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the said land")  
HEREBY ADMIT for the purposes of Section 34 (6) of the Highways Act, 1959  
that the Bridleways indicated on the said plan have been dedicated as highways  
with their use limited to Bridleways and DECLARE that these are the only  
highways within the said land:

- (A) Bridleway No.1 : From Priory Road at the eastern boundary of the said  
land passed Hill Farm Cottages to the western boundary  
of the said land along the roadway leading to Bankwood Farm.
- (B) Bridleway No.2 : From the junction of Priory Drive and the A 612 Nottingham/  
Southwell Road along the southern boundary of the said land  
passed Souther Wood and thence to Bridleway No.3 at its  
junction with the Bridleway leading to Hagg Farm.

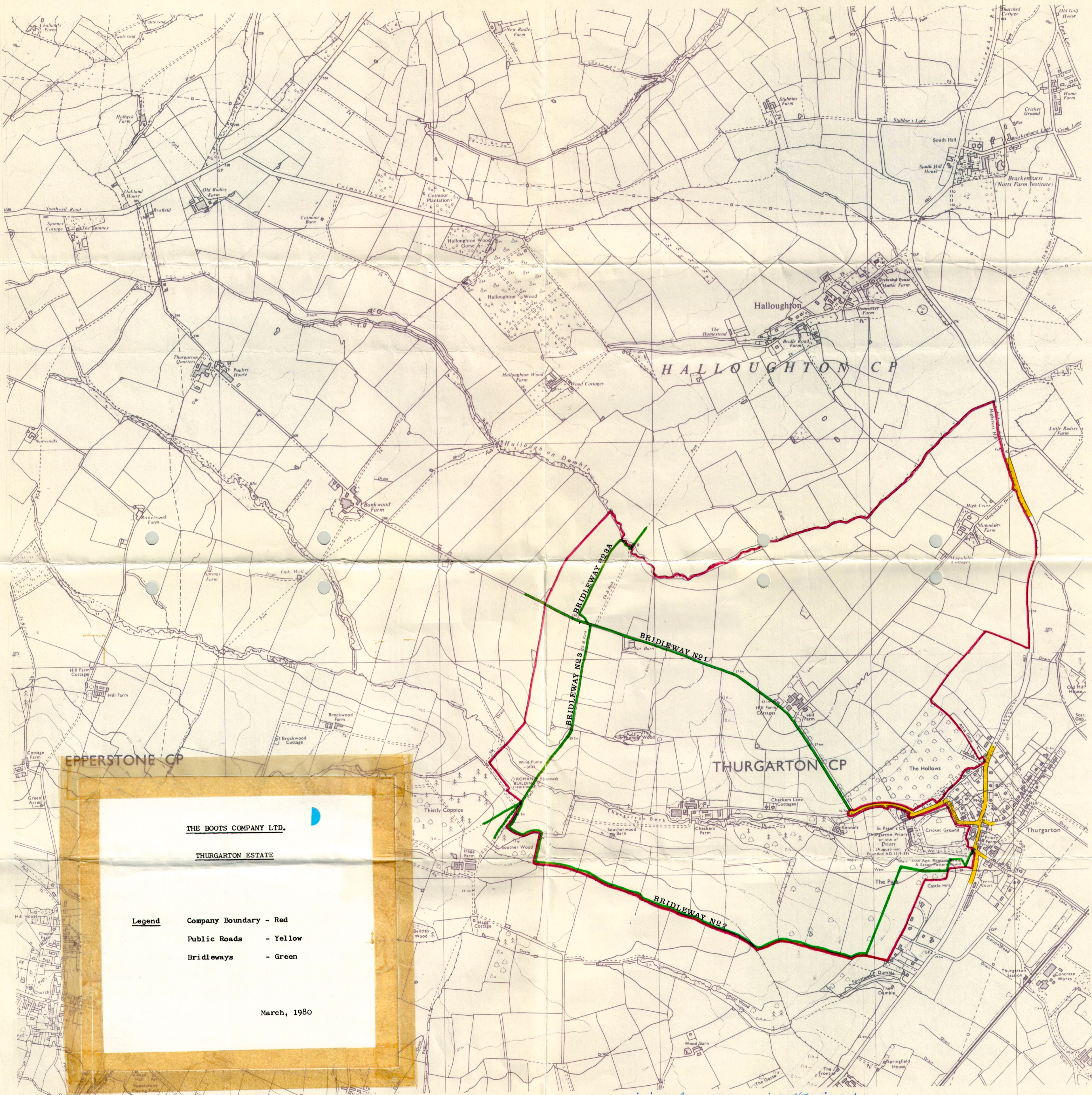
(C) Bridleway No. 3: From the western boundary of the said land and Hagg Farm proceeding northwards, crossing Bridleway No.1, and continuing to the northern boundary of the said land.

For ease of reference the roads which are highways are shown coloured yellow on the said plan where they provide access to the said land.
