**SECTION 31 (6) - HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

Following our telephone conversation (4 November 1998) concerning public rights of way in the Parish of Everton, I enclose two forms relating to the lodgement of a statutory declaration in accordance with Section 31 (6) Highways Act 1980. These must be completed and accompanied by a plan of a scale not less than 1:10,000 showing:-

1. The boundaries of the land owned by the Parish Council.
2. All dedicated public rights of way over land owned by the Parish Council.

The statutory declaration ensures that no additional public rights of way are dedicated over the land delineated on the map mentioned above starting from the date when the forms have been deposited. However, it will not prevent the dedication of any paths which have been used for at least 20 years prior to the date of the statutory declaration. Also this documentation must be renewed every six years.

I would suggest that you complete the enclosed forms in pencil at the outset and return them with your plan to myself at the address shown at the top of this letter. This will enable me to check that the plan shows all of the dedicated public rights of way in their precise locations and coloured correctly according to their status.

## SECTION 31 (6) - HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Thank you for your letter dated 5th November 98 concerning public rights of way in the parish of Everton, and I now return herewith a statutory declaration, deposit of statement and plan, duly completed, together with a copy of the definitive map and statement issued by Nottinghamshire County Council (area 6) and the Modification Order 1992.

I have outlined the parish land in the vicinity of the claimant, in red Marked A and B, and marked the agreed bridleways in that area in green. These ways were originally R.U.P.P s but under the Modification Order 1992 were redesignated as Bridleways.

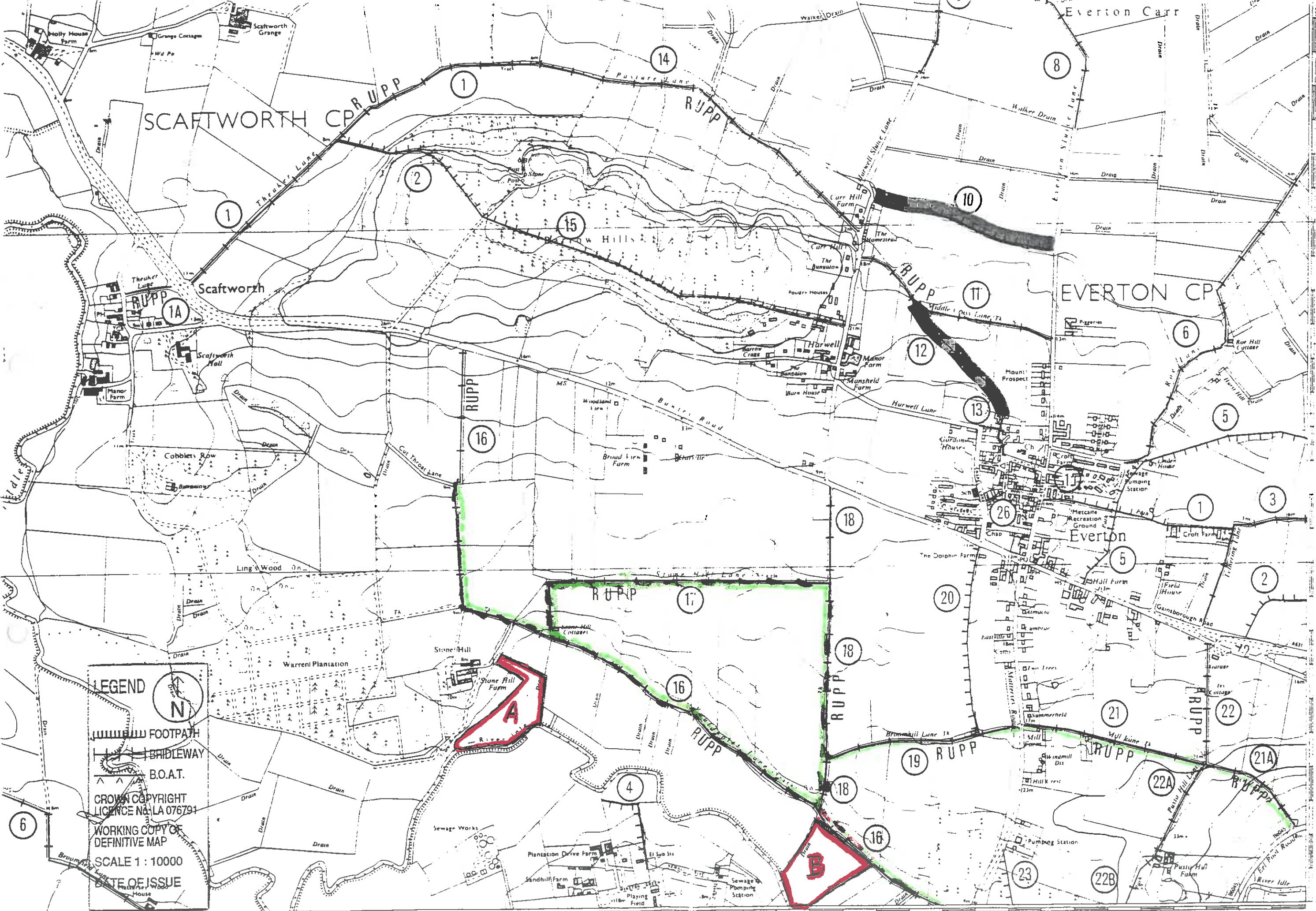
