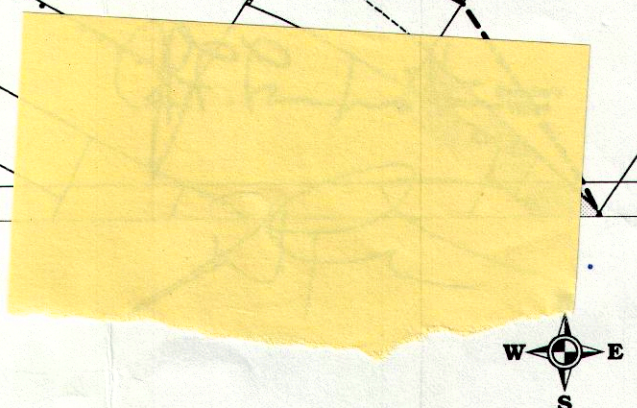


**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL; DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT PLAN

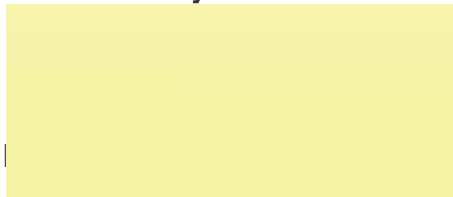
