property.

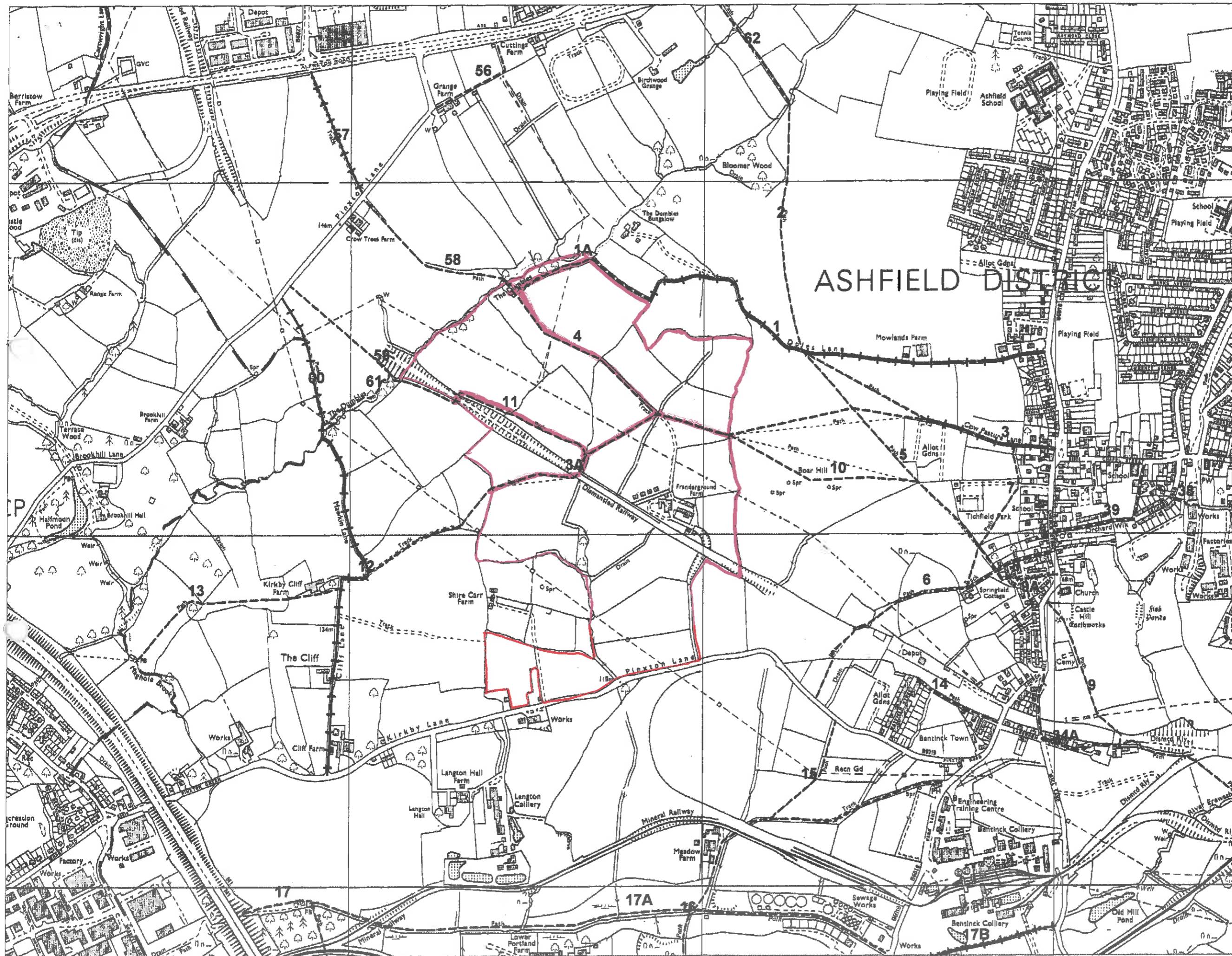


