

PRESERVATION OF MOD RIGHTS IN MOD PRIVATE ROADS AND FOOTPATHS PROCEDURE UNDER SECTION 31(6) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 allows the Ministry of Defence to protect and preserve its rights in its private roads and footpaths which the general public are permitted to use, or which are open to use by the public.

This necessitates the deposit of plans and statements with the relevant county councils, indicating what ways, if any, have been dedicated as highways, which will subsequently be supported by statutory declarations, renewable at intervals of not more than six years. These subsequent declarations will state that no additional ways have been dedicated since the original deposit or previous declaration, unless specifically indicated. The sites referred to apply only to land where MOD has the freehold interest and not to leased sites occupied by the MOD.

The original deposits should have been made at the time the Highways Act came into force and this constituted an agreement under Section 327 of the Act. However, I understand from our records that a deposit was never made to Nottinghamshire County Council at that time, nor was a submission made at a later date.

I am therefore writing to advise you that we intend to make a deposit of plans and declarations in the near future relating to highways on the MOD sites which fall within the county. Please expect documents relating to the following sites:

It would be appreciated if you would respond to this letter as soon as possible, confirming that the Council is willing to accept the forthcoming deposit as a Section 327 agreement, and consequently agreeing to accept any subsequent declarations made by MOD. In replying, perhaps you may also indicate to whom the deposit of plans should be addressed. You may also wish to send copies of the plans to the relevant Local Authorities, once you have received the originals from MOD.

Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan, and I am to confirm that the extent of public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:

- a. Over each route shown by continuous purple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
- b. Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
- c. Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
- d. Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint, the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs "a", "b" and "c" are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council under the provision of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, as amended by the Countryside Act 1968. The routes indicated by paragraph "d" are more particularly described on the plans attached.



Please confirm that the highways shown on the enclosed plans coincide with those shown on the Definite Map.

Statutory Declaration will be lodged with you from time to time as required.

#### CONVENIES ON SEMESTROPHORY DECREARAGE ON

Thank you for your letter and enclosures dated 20th December 1983 concerning rights of way and checked by my footpaths department for any discrepancies.

With reference to plan no. SK53NE, your ref: NOTTS/R.O.F./1081, relating to the Royal Ordnance Factory Site, a problem was encountered.

The Nottingham City Council has instigated adoption procedures for various paths within the City boundaries prior to the production of a definitive map for the entire city.

It is proposed to show a bridlepath, rurning along the southern boundary of the Royal Ordnance factory as drawn in green on the attached plan no.1.

I would be grateful if you would confirm whether the boundary of the R.O.F. is to the north of the projected pathline.

If the pathline falls within the boundary would you consider whether it should be included in the Declaration.

We accept all the plans referred to in the Declaration except for plan no. NOTTS/NEWT/1011.

With reference to enclosed plan no.2, it is presumed that in 1957 when Bradmore F.P. 2 was claimed, the Parish considered that, at least footpath status existed along the stretch of road, marked in red on the attached plan, providing a link with Ruddington F.P.7 and the A60.

If this is not agreeable could a dedication of footpath status be raised on the area of land marked red on the attached plan. Your comments on these matters would be appreciated.

I am directed to deposit with you, under the provisions of Sub-Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 the enclosed plans of the Ministry of Defence Establishments within your area, more particularly numbered and named below and upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence admits have been dedicated as highways.

- 2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan, and I am to confirm that the extent of public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:
  - a. Over each route shown by continuous purple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
  - b. Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
  - c. Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purpose for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
  - d. Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs a, b and c are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council under the provisions of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, as amended by the Countryside Act 1968. The routes indicated by paragraph d. are more particularly described in detail on the plans attached.
