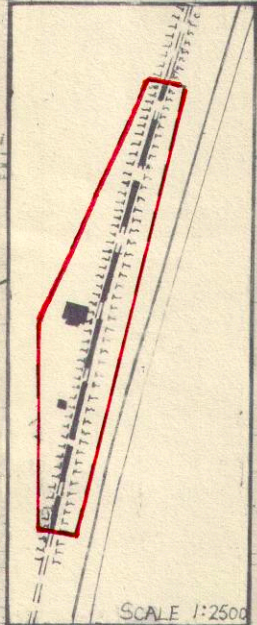
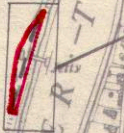
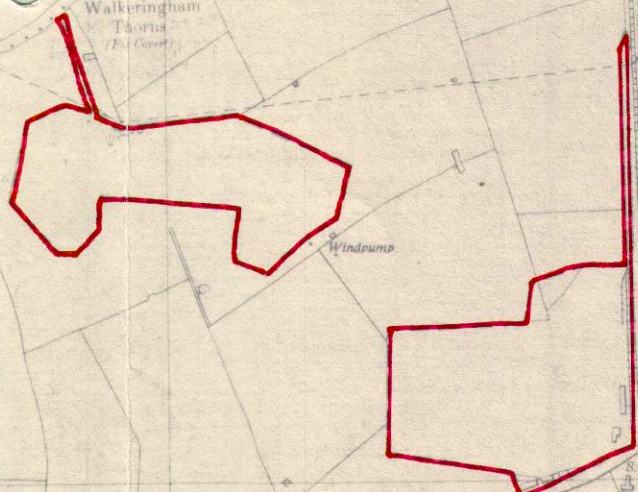

**SECTION 31(6) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 - RAF PETROLEUM
STORAGE DEPOT, MISTERTON, NOTTS**

I refer to the DoE Property Services Agency's letter dated 17 January 1978 enclosing a plan of Ministry of Defence premises at the RAF Petroleum Storage Depot at Misterton and containing a statement made under Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 (now superseded by Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980) indicating what ways over these premises were admitted to be dedicated as highways.

SECTION 31(6) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

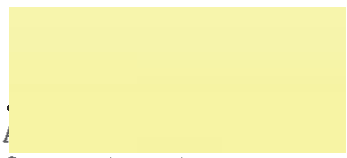
I, ALLAN ROBBIE BAILLIE, Defence Land Agent in the MINISTRY OF DEFENCE at Nottingham, acting on behalf of THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE under the authority conferred upon me by the said Secretary of State DC SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. On the seventeenth of January 1978 and in accordance with Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959, now superseded by Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980, the Secretary of State for Defence caused to be deposited with the Nottinghamshire County Council and the Bassetlaw District Council a map of certain land and buildings vested in the said Secretary of State and located at the RAF Petroleum Storage Depot at Misterton (within the areas administered by such Councils) together with a statement indicating what ways over the said land were admitted by the said Secretary of State to have been dedicated as highways.

2. No additional way over the land delineated on the map so deposited with the Nottinghamshire County Council has been dedicated as a highway since the twenty-third day of December 1983 being the date of the lodgement in accordance with the said Section of a previous Declaration dated the twenty-second day of December 1983 made in respect of the said land.



SECTION 34 - THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

1. I am directed to deposit with you under the Provisions of Sub-Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 the enclosed plan numbered 19 of the Ministry of Defence Establishment within your area, and more particularly known as RAF Petroleum Supply Depot, MISTERTON upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence admits have been dedicated as Highways.

2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan and I am to confirm that the extent of public right recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:

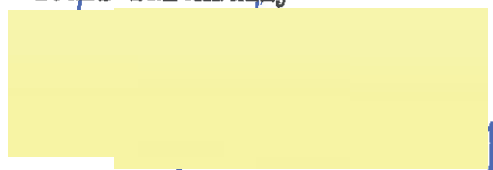
(a) Over each route shown by — — — the Secretary of State recognises a Highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.

(b) Over each route shown by — | — | — the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horse-back or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the Highway.

(c) Over each route shown by — ^ — ^ — the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

3. Statutory declarations will be lodged with you from time to time as required.
