What will we do with the information?

We will use the information provided as part of our work with local authorities and the Government to improve adult care leavers' access to their social care records.

Further to your recent Freedom Of Information Request below. I am afraid that the information we hold does not meet your request specifically, however I have been informed of some details that be of benefit to you.

Nottinghamshire County Councils Complaints and Information Team did not undertake requests for SAR requests for Social Care records until July 2014, so we are unable to provide figures for this year.

The number of requests received for 2015 in total, was 198 and for 2016 it was 168.

These figures represent the number of requests received by the department overall and not requests where ID was provided and subsequently processed by the team for release. Unfortunately we do not capture information by category as requested below, and so we are unable to identify those requests received from adult care leavers for their own social care records.
