

Freedom of information request NCC-028441-17

Thank you for your recent communication on the following:

Could you please give the reasoning why the speed camera warning sign on the B6041, just past the junction of Thievesdale lane and Farmers Branch, is facing away from the oncoming traffic moving towards the regular positioning of the speed camera van, at the junction of farmers branch and Blythe Road B6045.

Our response:

I have arranged for an officer to investigate your concerns, I have been advised the permanent metal safety warning signs are positioned correctly.

In addition there is one metal "camera" sign near the primary school which has been erected to warn motorists about enforcement of the parking regulations in that area.

Furthermore there are two additional plastic "camera" signs strapped to lamp columns with cable ties; these may be the ones that your enquiry is about, as these may be prone to rotation with wind-loading. These signs are the responsibility of Nottinghamshire Police. Nottinghamshire County Council do not have control over these plastic signs nor the locations that the police choose to park their van when enforcing speed limits.
