About Church Street Care Home

Church Street Care Home provides eight long term residential placements for adults with learning disabilities (aged 18 – 65). Residents are supported to live within their community and the aim is to increase their level of independence.

Our professional staff are highly skilled and trained. We provide bespoke care and support services to adults with additional complex behavioural needs. We can provide one to one support with all areas of care including personal care, health and well-being, nutritional, social, educational and recreational activities. We work with each resident to find out how they would like to be supported so they can live their life in a safe and fulfilling way.

Facilities include a large spacious lounge / dining room, kitchen, quiet area, laundry room, walk-in shower and two bathrooms, one with a bath chair.

All eight bedrooms are furnished, but residents can bring their own furniture if they wish.

Location and area

Church Street is in a quiet residential area, within walking distance of Eastwood Town Centre.

In the town centre, residents can access banks, clothing shops, supermarkets and there are bus connections into Nottingham and Derbyshire.

There are plenty of parks and open spaces nearby, with Shipley Park approximately 10 minutes away and the Derbyshire Dales less than half an hour's drive away.
