**Request for Information: Ref NCC-030183-17**

**Young people between the ages of 16 and 19 who were at any time classified as NEET(Not in Education, Employment or Training).**

Thank you for your request for information relating to NEET statistics. I can now let you have the following information in response to the questions you raised.

**Please list all years from 2000-date for which the Local Authority holds aggregate data concerning the total numbers of young people between the ages of 16 and 19 who were at any time classified as NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training) and were resident in the Local Authority area.**

Nottingham County Council have a contract with Futures who manage and collate NEET data on our behalf. Futures has confirmed that they do not hold data dating back to 2000, futures hold aggregate data from 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

**Please list all years from 2000-date for which the Local Authority holds individual records of young people between the ages of 16 and 19 who were at any time classified as NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training), were resident in the Local Authority area, and whose records include the following identifiers:**

- **Given/first name**
- **Family / last name**
- **Middle name**
- **Date of birth**
- **Sex**
- **Home address**
- **Postcode**

Individualised data this is only retained until a young person becomes 21 unless they have an SEND (Special Education Needs & Disability). Futures would have individualised data for the last 5 years only 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 up until today.
