

**Request for Information: Ref NCC-026471-17**

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act about roadworks on Hamilton Way in Mansfield. You asked;

“Under the FOI Act I wish to know why NCC have recently carried out works at the above location in the last three months which has led to the bizarre situation of a pavement being removed for a proposed junction, when the junction has not been started in any way, shape or form. I wish to know what the thought process was here, who authorised the work, how much the work cost and why it was felt necessary / a priority when so many road surfaces are in a poor state, yet there is apparently no money for these works to take place?”

I am pleased to advise that we are now able to provide the following information;

- The works on Hamilton road are to facilitate a proposed light industrial works area
- These works were paid for by the private developer
- Only part of the works have been undertaken as the planning consent stipulated that work must be started, this consent was running out!
- The new junction has been left safe, with tactile paving laid both sides.
- No public money has funded these works.
