The attached document gives the information NCC are able to provide about the allocation of places. The following schools use catchment within the oversubscription criteria; West

Bridgford Infant, Lady Bay Primary, Abbey Road Primary, Jesse Grey Primary, Heymann Primary and Edwalton Primary School. St Edmund Campion Catholic Primary Academy and Pierrepont Gamston Primary School do not use catchment as part of the oversubscription criteria. - In a reply to an existing FOIA request referenced NCC 026654-17, it states that, correct to that date, 36 schools have gone over their PAN. We would like to know in what circumstances those increases in PAN were granted please.

The FOI related to the position at 15.8.17 and in the majority of cases these were successful appeals. Admission authorities may admit above the PAN at any time following determination as outlined in the School Admissions Code 2014 paragraph 1.4. Paragraph 2.15 of the code gives details of the limited exceptional circumstances in which an infant class may contain more than 30 pupils with a single school teacher. Nottinghamshire County Council makes admission decisions for community and voluntary controlled schools.
