Thank you for your request for information regarding:

Are you responsible for the processing of Schedule 14 claims for public rights of way. (Schedule 14 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) If you are not please provide the name of the authority that is for your region.

If so, has there ever been a situation whereby the application has been dismissed, thrown out or had to be resubmitted, due to an administrative error. Such as (but not limited to) the incorrect completion of the forms or failure to follow the guidelines correctly.

Our response:

Nottinghamshire County Council "NCC" are the surveying authority for schedule 14 applications. NCC do occasionally receive incomplete applications or those with errors from time to time but we point these out to the applicant and they normally get amended. We've had applications where the applicant has failed to serve notice on the landowners, again we'll make sure the applicant is made aware.
