
Transition

Noun: The process or a period of changing from one state or condition to another.


Verb: Undergo or cause to undergo a process or period of transition


From education to work

Why transition is a key issue in social care

- Young people who use social care services are likely to have additional needs and/or have had difficult life experiences
- The timing of transitions for young people who use social care is determined by law, policy and availability of resources rather than individual maturity and personal choice
- Services struggle to replicate the flexible support that many/most young people receive from their parents and kin networks
