What support can I get?

Social care clinics can provide you with emotional and practical support if you are aged 65 and over and are struggling to live independently at home due to an illness or disability.

The service also offers support and advice if you care for someone who is aged 65 and over who has an illness or a disability.

How can I use the service?

Contact us on **0300 500 80 80** if you wish to use the service. You can also make a referral on behalf of someone you know if they are struggling.

The service is provided over the phone or by appointment at one of the clinics in Worksop or Retford.

Home visits are available if you have difficulty with your mobility.
