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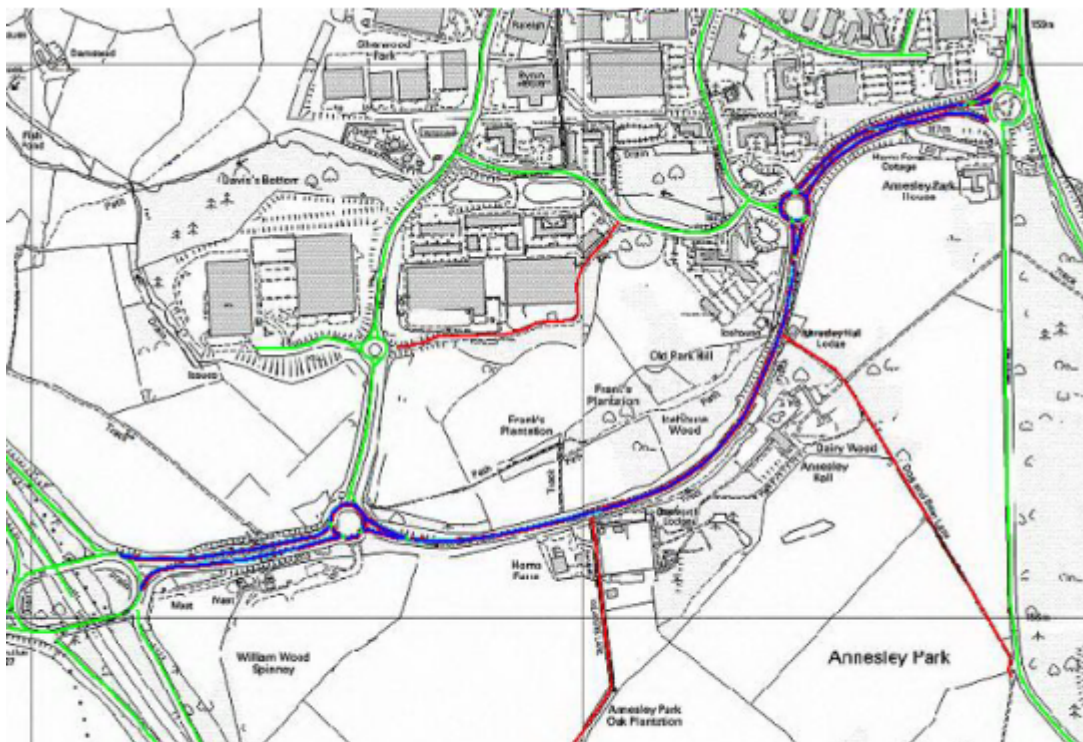

Dates of all safety inspections in relation to the roundabout east of Junction 27

Thank you for your request for information relating to all safety inspections in relation to the roundabout east of Junction 27. I can now let you have the following information in response to the questions you raised.



Street Section covered: Mansfield Road - USRN 1203184 Feature No. 2000

Dates of all safety inspections undertaken on the carriageway in the two years preceding the date of your incident See attached Street History Report

Details of all carriageway defects identified during safety inspections in the two years preceding your incident See attached Street History Report

Details of how carriageway safety inspections are undertaken, including whether walked or driven, the speed of the inspection vehicle and the number of persons in the vehicle. The means of undertaking inspections is contained in the attached Highway Inspection & Risk Manual.

The intended frequency of carriageway safety inspections. Monthly

Details of all complaints and/or enquiries relating to the carriageway, received in the two years preceding your incident. See attached Street History Report
