

Governor Services Privacy Notice

Introduction

This privacy notice explains how the Council uses your data to deliver an advice, guidance, training and clerking service to school governing bodies as a sold service.

Who will be using your data?

Nottinghamshire County Council will be the data controller for the data you provide to us.

We may also contract third party organisations to process your data on our behalf.

What personal data do we use?

- Name and title
- Date of Birth
- Images
- Home or school address
- Email address
- Employment and education information
- Family details
- Business Activities
- Parent/carer details

What types of special category personal data do we need from you?

- Racial or ethnic origin
- Physical and mental health details

We also process data about criminal convictions, criminal offences or related security measures.

Why do we use your data?

- For service delivery
- For service planning, training and improvement
- For ensuring safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults

What legal reasons allow us to use your data in this way?

Our legal basis for processing your personal data is that it is necessary to perform our public tasks as a Local Authority.

Our legal basis for processing your special category personal data is that it is for reasons of substantial public interest and/or necessary for the council to carry out its obligations relating to employment.

Our legal basis for processing data about criminal convictions, criminal offences or related security measures is that it is necessary to perform our public tasks as a local authority.

Who may we share your data with or receive it from?

- Service Providers
- Schools & Academies
- Education providers
- Government organisations
- The Police
- The disclosure and barring service
- Religious organisations

May personal data be transferred overseas?

The Council may for operational purposes transfer personal data overseas. In these cases, we will ensure that your personal data is protected and there are safeguards for the protection of your rights. Please refer to the Council's privacy statement for further details.

How long is your data kept for?

This information is held in accordance with the Council's retention schedule – see here.

What will happen if you do not provide or we cannot obtain the data needed?

- We could not provide advice, guidance and the clerking service to schools.
- We could not ensure that school governors meet the qualification and disqualification requirements as set out in The School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012

Does the service make decisions using fully automated processes?

What rights do you have over this use of your data?

- To be informed about how we use your data
- To access a copy of your data that we process
- To have us rectify or correct your data that we process
- To restrict our processing of your personal data
- To object to the use of your data
- To have your personal data erased
- To request that we transfer your information to you or another organisation

- To object to fully automated decision making
- To withdraw your consent (if it the legal reason why we use your data).
