Further to your recent request for information please see below.

Information on total annual spend for the following -

- * Flood defences - broken down by type and annual spend per type

NCC are responsible for investigating surface water flooding and often flood prevention measures are jointly funded. Therefore, without a little more information we are not able to answer this enquiry. If you would like to contact Sue Jaques, Team Manager – Flood Risk Management, she will be able to assist and provide a specific response.

- * Temporary roadways/paths - broken down by type and annual spend per type

- * Ground protection and temporary access solutions currently used

- * Contact details of whom deals with ground protection and temporary roadways

This type of solution is used very infrequent and when the required, this generally forms part of a more major scheme and hence forms part of a tendered solution. Therefore, we do not have individual records associated with the provision of temporary roadways and ground protection, as they do not form part of the permanent highway asset and hence they are not recorded in the Highway Asset Management System.
