724 NCC highway bridges on the adopted highway with spans equal or longer than 1.5m.

a) How many are not fit to carry vehicles which weigh 7.5 tonnes or more? 2 bridges.

b) How many are in need of some degree of repair/and or enhancement to carry such vehicles - As above

c) What would the total estimated cost be to carry out all required work on those bridges - Approximately £200k

d) How many do the local authority intend to repair and or/enhance so they may carry such vehicles, within the next 5 financial years and what is the estimated cost of those repairs?- None – there is no urgency or desire to strengthen/enhance as they are on minor parts of the Network with good alternative routes; one is a grade 2 listed structure which the weight limit protects.

Q3. How much has the local authority spent on highways infrastructure in each of the preceding 5 financial years; and what proportion of annual council spending did that figure comprise?
