**Introduction**

Nottinghamshire County Council is one of the Nottinghamshire health and social care providers that participates in the Nottinghamshire Community Care Portal. The community portal enables providers to electronically share your health and social care information, such as hospital and GP attendances, test results, medication and care plans with providers that subscribe to the Nottinghamshire Community Care Portal. With your explicit consent health and social care professionals, or staff who are supervised by health and social care professionals, will be able to access this information to better coordinate and provide care to you. Access is strictly controlled and the shared record is hosted by Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust in their secure data centre.

**What personal data do we use?**

- Name and Contact Details
- Age
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- NHS number
- Address
- Social Care ID
- Family details
- Parent/carer details
- Emergency contacts
- Case file information

**What types of special category personal data do we need from you?**

- Social care support outcomes
- Physical and mental health details

**Why do we use your data?**

- For service delivery
- To provide direct care to our service users

**What legal reasons allow us to use your data in this way?**

Our legal basis for processing your personal data is that it is necessary to perform our public tasks as a local authority.

Our legal basis for processing your special category personal data is that it is necessary for the provision and management of health or social care services.

**What will happen if you do not provide or we cannot obtain the data needed?**

We could not provide the most efficient and responsive health or social care services that you need.

**Who may we share your data with or receive it from?**

- NHS agencies (GPs, Hospitals)

**Does the service make decisions using fully automated processes?**

**Who will be using your data?**

Nottinghamshire County Council will process your data and we may also contract third parties to process your data on our behalf

**May personal data be transferred overseas?**

- To object to fully automated decision making
- To withdraw your consent (if it the legal reason why we use your data).
