Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information Request.

I am now able to provide you with the information supplied by the relevant department, as follows:

The average Cost of filling in a pothole.

We do not identify the costs associated with the repair of potholes separately to the delivery of the whole reactive maintenance service. This includes potholes, patching, paving repairs and similar activities to carriageways, footways and verges necessary to keep the Highway safe for users. Overall the budget for such activities is £2.4m per year and this is the annual cost of delivering the service.

· Average time scale for filling in a pothole.

All potholes are inspected and where they meet the County Council's investigation criteria a repair is order. Depending on the location, position, depth, risk and other local factors, a repair will be undertaken within either 1 day, 28 days or 90 days (Categorised as 1, 2 or 3). The following table will give you a better understanding of the numbers of potholes that we have dealt with in Nottinghamshire over the last three years and whilst a large proportion of these are Cat 1s ie fixed in less than a day, there is a mix across all categorise and the seasons and environmental condition have a major influence on the numbers arising.

The following table shows the number of enquiries the County Council has received regarding potholes on the Highway. Not all of these will have resulted in work being undertaken but you will see by comparing the numbers reported and the numbers done that the majority of potholes are identified through the Planned Inspection Regime whereby the highway infrastructure is inspected at a set frequency depending on its use and hierarchy.
