

Calling all working parents of 3 and 4 year olds



Working parents of 3 and 4 year olds may be eligible for up to 30 hours of government funded childcare a week.

Take advantage of 30 hours funded childcare for 3 and 4 year olds

To be eligible, both parents must be working (or sole parent in a lone parent family) and each parent earn on average:

- a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage (under 25 yr olds) or national living wage (over 25 yrs old); and
- less than £100,000 per year.

'Childcare Choices' also offers help to access Tax-Free Childcare, childcare vouchers and free childcare or education for 2 to 4 year olds. Successful applicants for 30 hours will receive an eligibility code, once you have this, please take your code to your chosen childcare provider as quickly as possible and request for your child's code to be validated. Parents must apply before the end of each school term to secure a place for the next term.
