This information is variable with each council and is depending on their waiting lists. Once the case is allocated again some councils fast track stair lifts/ramps and some don't. Timeframes are also dependent on whether there is a project officer overseeing the works or whether Parents are in control of Project Managing. If Parents are in control, the works can take a lot longer to be completed. Below is the estimate of minimum timeframes based on our experience.
