HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

AND

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

NOTICE is hereby given that Public Inquiries in connection with the Orders mentioned below will be held by an Inspector, appointed for this purpose by the Secretary of State for Transport, **beginning at 10.00 am on 11 June 2019 at the St Georges Centre, 91 Victoria Road, Netherfield, Nottingham NG4 2NN**. This is to hear representations from remaining objectors (as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007), statutory objectors (as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994), from any other persons having an interest in the land the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order and, at his discretion, to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

THE ORDERS are Orders which have been made by Nottinghamshire County Council under the above-mentioned Acts and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation. Namely:-

(1) THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B684 TO A612 LINK ROAD) A6211 GEDLING ACCESS ROAD (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2018. *An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980.*

(2) THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GEDLING ACCESS ROAD) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2018. *An Order under sections 239, 240, 246 and 250 of the Highways Act 1980.*

relating to highways or private means of access all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as the A6211 Gedling Access Road which the Council propose to construct from the B684 Mapperley Plains in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 3.8km to its junction with the A612 at Trent Valley Road and Nottingham Road in the Borough of Gedling in the County of Nottinghamshire.

PROCEEDINGS on the above-mentioned Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of Section 257 of the Highways Act 1980.

COPIES of the Orders and of the plans referred to therein have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge at the offices of Nottinghamshire County Council, County Hall, Loughborough Road, West Bridgford, Nottingham NG2 7QP and at the following libraries:

- (d) Carlton Library, Manor Road, Carlton, Nottingham, NG4 3AY.

COPIES of any proofs of evidence, sent to or by the promoting authority, are also available for inspection at Nottinghamshire County Council from 21 May 2019.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby directs that any person who intends to submit at the Inquiries that any highway or proposed highway to which the Orders relate should follow an alternative route, or that instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the Orders relate, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to him at Department for Transport, National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle upon Tyne NE4 7AR, not later than **21 May 2019**, sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway (as the case may be) to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the person holding the Inquiries to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
