(A) SIMS for Primary & Special Schools Demonstration

An overview of how SIMS and the new cloud-based version of the software, SIMS Primary, can be best used to support the day to day running of a Primary or Special school. It will focus on how SIMS can be used to track and monitor attendance, behaviour and assessment, supporting the work of administrators, teachers and leaders. There will also be an emphasis on how the use of reports and dashboards aids leaders and governors in the analysis of whole school performance, enabling effective self-evaluation and in evidencing the impact of the school's actions to tackle underperformance.

(B) ScholarPack for Primary & Special Schools Demonstration

ScholarPack's, feature-rich management system allows schools to make sense of their data and see what's really going on. From attendance and assessments to accidents and incidents, ScholarPack helps schools record, manage and review everything that's going on. And the result? All round smarter schools.

(C) How SIMS can support schools with the new Ofsted Education Inspection Framework (Primary, Special & Secondary)

This session will explore the changes to the Ofsted Framework and how SIMS will continue to support schools in providing evidence against the four judgement areas from September 2019. There is a particular focus on the new Quality of Education judgement and how SIMS Assessment can be best used to align with Ofsted's emphasis on the curriculum being at the heart of the new framework.

(D) How ScholarPack supports Schools with Ofsted – Including Assessment and Wraparound Care

Recording, analysing progress and attainment for all cohorts, and an overview of support, behaviour, interventions and club's functionality.

(E) SIMS for Secondary Schools Demonstration

An overview of how SIMS can be best used to support the day to day running of a Secondary school, supporting the work of administrators, teachers and leaders. It will focus on how SIMS can be used by pastoral staff to track and monitor attendance and behaviour plus targeted interventions. In addition, you will be shown how SIMS Assessment supports curriculum planning at Key Stage 3. and Key Stage 4 as well as its implementation and how the impact of teaching can be measured by middle and senior leaders across all subjects. Finally, there will be an emphasis on how the use of reports and dashboards aids leaders and governors in the analysis of whole school performance, enabling effective self-evaluation and in evidencing the impact of the school's actions to tackle underperformance.
