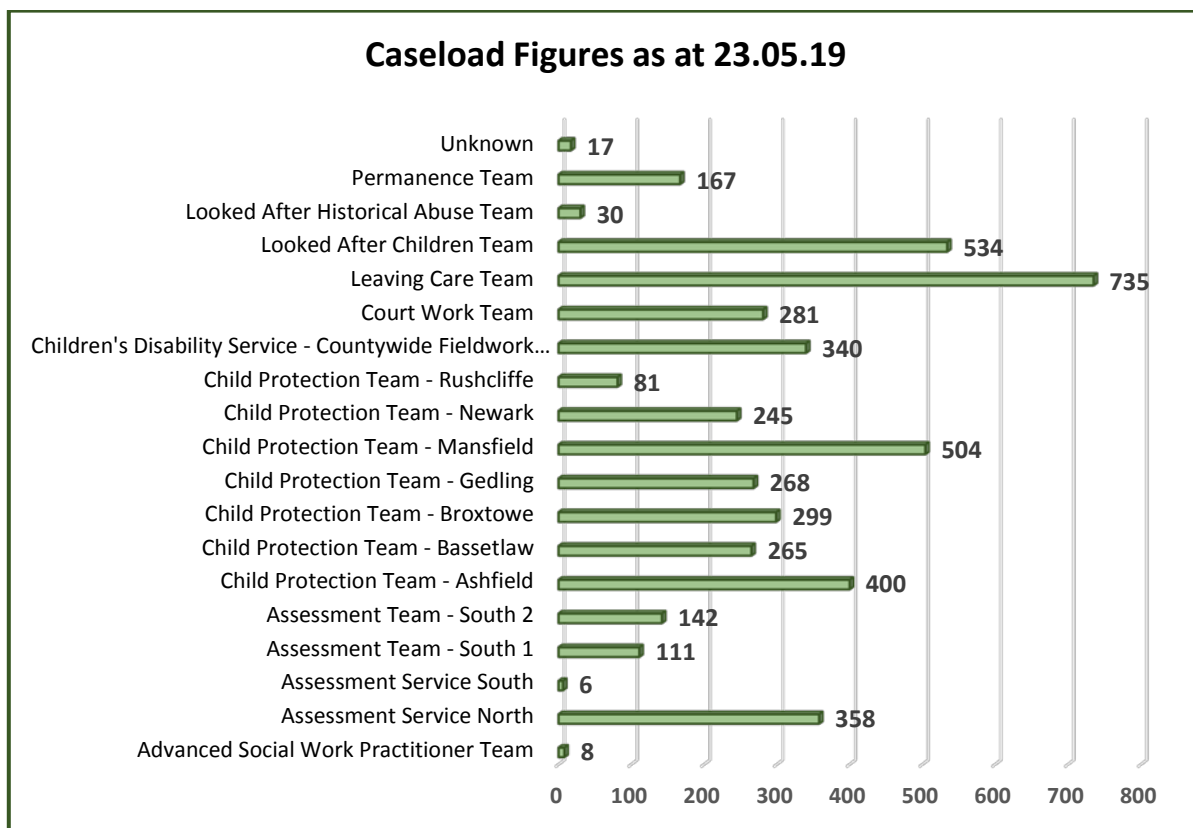
We don't keep data on criminal records. Whilst we would put any convictions on the young person's file we would not be able to pull off a report which would collate this data.
