



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(NEWTON BRIDLEWAY NO.4)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**NEWTON BRIDLEWAY NO.4**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2023**.

That Notice came into force on 23rd October 2023.

The effects are that no person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of Bridleway at Newton in the Borough of Rushcliffe:

Newton Bridleway No.4, between its junction with Bridleway No.6 and No.7 at the edge of the A46, and the junction with newton Footpath No.5, a distance of approximately 1000 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 22nd April 2024 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on the 13th November 2023 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety and enable drainage and surfacing improvements to be made to the bridleway.
