

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with the provisions of Section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act (EIA) 2006 that Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make a prescribed alteration to Broomhill Community Junior School, located on Broomhill Road, Hucknall, Nottingham, NG15 6AJ, by expanding the school's net capacity from 240 permanent pupil places to 300 permanent places from 1 September 2015.

It is intended that the number of pupils to be admitted into the first age group of the school (Published Admission Number) will permanently increase from 60 to 75 in September 2015.
