Nottinghamshire Overview

1. Claimant Counts

As of July 2019, the claimant count for the Nottinghamshire region totals 20,435. This is 5,485 more than it was a year ago and represents a rate of 3.10% which, in comparison to the East Midlands region, is 0.70% higher.

For the City and the County, this equates to a total of 9,070 and 11,365 claimants respectively, with rates of 3.90% and 2.30%.

Across Nottinghamshire, an overall increase of 575 has been seen against the previous month.

2. Claimant Counts by Districts

The claimant count increased in six Local Authority Districts in the County over the month. The largest increase was in Gedling, which saw a rise of 100, equalling a change of 6.69%.

This is followed by Mansfield which increased by 60 individuals, totalling 3.16%, and Newark & Sherwood, whereby an increase of 45 was seen, representing 3.06%. Bassetlaw saw a decrease of 15 individuals, or -0.80%.

Regarding gender, Bassetlaw has the greatest number of male claimants' percentage wise, with 1085 individuals totalling 61.39%. Newark & Sherwood has the most female claimants by percentage, with 660 claimants, or 43.42%.

3. Claimant Counts by Parliamentary Constituencies

Claimants increased in seven of the eight Parliamentary Constituencies in the County during July. The largest increase was in Gedling with an increase of 75 over the previous month, representing a 5.60% rise.

Over the year, the rates of change range from 24.91% in Bassetlaw, to 53.29% in Newark. The average rate of change across all eight Constituencies is 43.97%.

4. Claimant Counts by Travel To Work Area (TTWA)

Compared to a year ago, all four of the TTWA's in the County have increased their claimant numbers. The largest change is Mansfield, with an increase of 48.65%. This is followed by Lincoln with 35.92%, Worksop & Retford with 31.19%, and Nottingham with 22.26%.

Against the previous month, Lincoln saw the largest growth in unemployment, increasing by 4.47%. This is followed by Mansfield on 3.23%, Nottingham on 2.96% and lastly Worksop & Retford, which saw a decrease of -0.74%.

As of July this year, Nottingham continues to have the greatest percentage of male claimants, on 62%. For female claimants, Worksop & Retford leads the way on 43%.

5. Claimant Rates by Ward

Of the wards within the Nottinghamshire area, Oak Tree, which is within the Mansfield district, continues to have the highest rate of claimants with 131, representing 6.70% of its 16-64 workforce population.

Comparatively, Bunny, within the Rushcliffe district, has the lowest rate, with there being no claimants at present.





Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & District for most recent period




Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period





Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex




Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years






Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period
