### Nottinghamshire Overview

#### 1. Claimant Counts

As of September 2019, the claimant count for the Nottinghamshire region totals 20,990. This is 6,285 more than it was a year ago and represents a rate of 3.20% which, in comparison to the East Midlands region, is 0.70% higher.

For the City and the County, this equates to a total of 9,385 and 11,605 claimants respectively, with rates of 4.10% and 2.30%.

Across Nottinghamshire, an overall increase of 275 has been seen against the previous month.

#### 2. Claimant Counts by Districts

The claimant count increased in five of the seven Local Authority Districts in the region over the month. The largest increase was in Newark and Sherwood, which saw a rise of 50, equalling a change of 3.24%.

This is followed by Bassetlaw and Broxtowe, both of which increased by 30 individuals, totalling 1.63% and 2.09% respectively. Gedling and Mansfield saw decreases of 20 and 15 individuals respectively.

Regarding gender, Broxtowe has the greatest number of male claimants' percentage wise, with 890 individuals totalling 60.75%. Newark & Sherwood has the most female claimants by percentage, with 710 claimants, or 44.51%.

#### 3. Claimant Counts by Parliamentary Constituencies

Claimants increased in six of the Parliamentary Constituencies in the region during September. The largest increase was in Bassetlaw, Broxtowe and Newark, which all increased by 35.

Over the year, the rates of change range from 17.97% in Bassetlaw, to 67.39% in Rushcliffe. The average rate of change across all eight Constituencies is 49.61%.

#### 4. Claimant Counts by Travel To Work Area (TTWA)

Compared to a year ago, all four of the TTWA's in the region have increased their claimant numbers. The largest change is Mansfield, with an increase of 58.90%. This is followed by Nottingham with 37.00%, Lincoln with 32.80% and Worksop & Retford with 16.20%.

Against the previous month, Worksop saw the largest growth in unemployment, increasing by 2.04%. This is followed by Nottingham on 1.20% and Mansfield on 0.60%. Lincoln decreased by 0.58%.

As of September this year, Nottingham continues to have the greatest percentage of male claimants, on 61%. For female claimants, Worksop & Retford leads the way on 44%.

#### 5. Claimant Rates by Ward

Of the wards within the Nottinghamshire area, Oak Tree, which is within the Mansfield district, continues to have the highest percentile of claimants with 136, representing 6.90% of its 16-64 workforce population.

Comparatively, Tollerton, within the Rushcliffe district, has the lowest rate, with there being 5 claimants, totalling 0.50% of its 16-64 workforce population.




Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & District for most recent period





Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period





Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex




Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years






Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period
