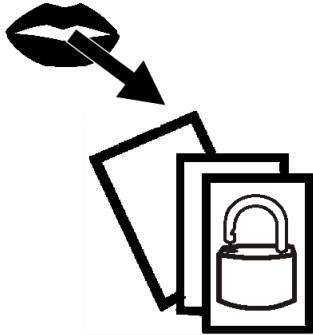
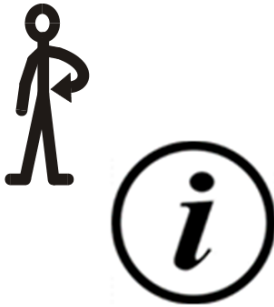




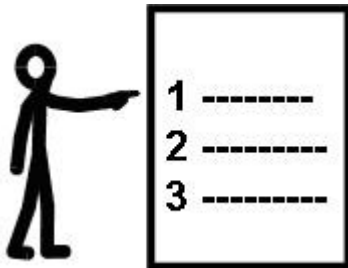
Easy Read Privacy Notice



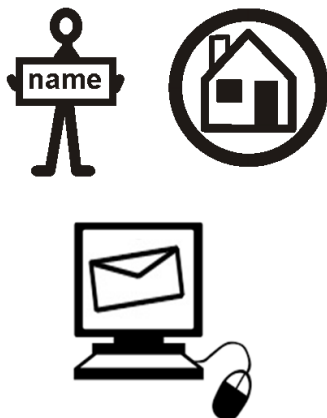
We are Nottinghamshire County Council, and we want to tell you about our privacy notice.



A privacy notice tells you how we use your personal information.



Personal information can be lots of different things. It can be;



- Your name, address, telephone number, date of birth, and email address



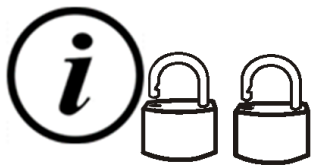
- Contact details of members of your family and people who support you



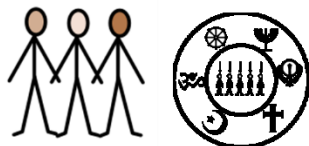
- Information about your money



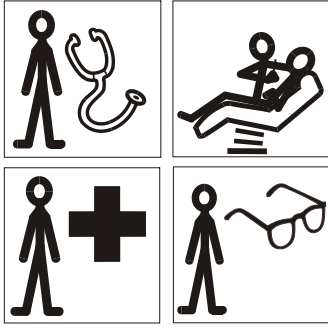
- Photographs and videos



We have to be careful with all personal information but some information we have to be extra careful with such as:



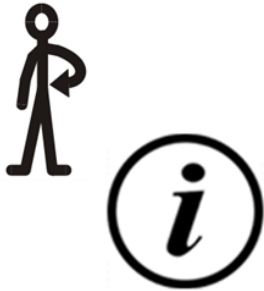
- Information about your race, beliefs or sexual orientation



- Information about your health conditions and disability



Sometimes we have to use information about crimes and breaking the law.



We use personal information for lots of different things for example;



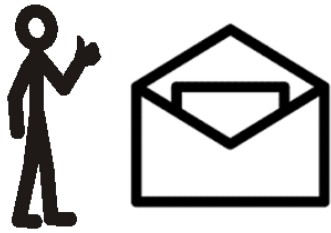
- So we can give you social care support



- Payments and charging for things



- Telling you about things that are happening



- Inviting you to events we think you might be interested in.



If we don't have your information, it could mean you miss out on the things we can do for you

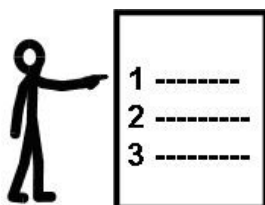


We only keep personal information for as long as we need it, unless the law says we must keep it for longer.

Sometimes we need to share your personal information with other organisations. This is to make sure you get the right support or help.



We might share information with:



Advocates



Your family or carers



Government organisations



NHS and GP's



Emergency services



Just because we have your personal information, it doesn't mean we can do what we want with it, we have to follow some rules.



Usually the rules say we can use your information, and we can do this without asking you first.



But sometimes we must ask for your agreement to use personal information, and if you say no, we can't.

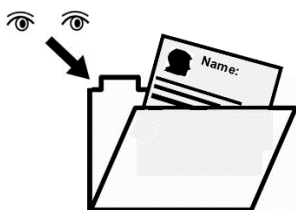
We will tell you if we need your agreement to use your personal information.



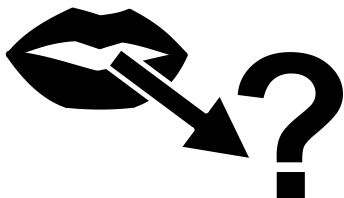
You have a right to:



Know what we are doing with your information and why we are doing it.



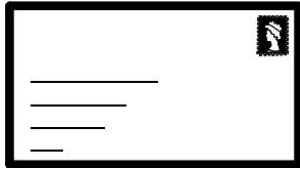
Ask us to give you the information we have about you.



Ask us to change any mistakes



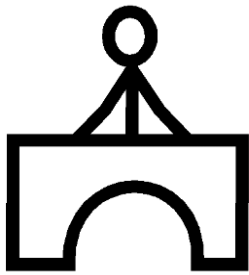
Ask us to stop using your personal information, or to delete it.

They are an independent organisation whose job it is to make sure we follow the rules.

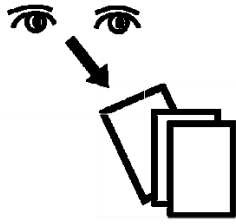
