Claimant Counts

As of October 2019, the **Claimant Count** for the Nottinghamshire region is 590 higher than it was a month ago. For the City, this equates to 9,595 claimants, whilst the County has 11,880, which is made up of 6,795 males and 5,080 females.

The claimant count also increased in all seven Local Authority **Districts** in the region, over the month. The largest increase was in Gedling, which saw a rise of 110 individuals, equalling a change of 6.92%. The smallest increase was Newark and Sherwood, which rose by only 5 individuals, or 0.32%.

Across the **Districts** gender wise, Ashfield has the greatest number of claimants with 2,270. This is broken down by 960 females and 1,310 males. The lowest is Rushcliffe with 940 claimants, made up of 405 females and 535 males.

As for the **Parliamentary Constituencies**, claimants increased in all eight during October. The largest increase was in Gedling, with a rise of 95 over the previous month, representing a 6.81% growth. The smallest was Newark, which rose by only 5 individuals, equalling 0.41%.

Compared to a year ago, the rates of change across **Parliamentary Constituencies** range from 17.10% in Bassetlaw, to 76.92% in Rushcliffe. The average rate of change across all eight areas is 52.51%.

Additionally, against the previous month, all four of the **TTWA's** have increased their claimant numbers. Nottingham saw the largest growth, increasing by 520 individuals, or 3.18%. The lowest was in Worksop and Retford, where an increase of 20 claimants was seen, equalling an increase of 1.00%.

Employment Counts

For the period of July 2018 to June 2019, **Employment** in Nottinghamshire totals 539,300. This is split between 148,100 individuals within the City and 391,200 across the remaining County, totalling 203,200 males and 188,000 females.

Within the **Districts**, Rushcliffe has the highest percentage of those in employment aged between 16 to 64, with 79.40%. The lowest in the region is Nottingham, with a rating of 64.40%. Of these, Gedling has the highest percentage of employees aged 16-64, with 69.70%. Bassetlaw has the highest self-employed rating, on 14.90%.

Of the **Parliamentary Constituencies**, five of these have increased in comparison to quarter one. This includes Ashfield, which totals 46,600, Bassetlaw on 47,900, Broxtowe on 50,700, Gedling on 46,300, and Sherwood on 46,700. Whilst Mansfield, Newark and Rushcliffe have decreased, with figures of 49,600, 52,000, and 51,400 respectively.

Gender wise, the **Parliamentary Constituency** of Ashfield has the greatest percentage of males aged 16-64 in employment, on 83.90%. Rushcliffe has the most females in employment for the same aged band, with a rating of 78.70%.

Comparatively, against the previous quarter, three of the four **TTWA's** have increased the number of individuals in employment in their respective regions. This includes Lincoln on 77.80%, an increase of 2.20%, Nottingham on 73.00%, up 1.60%, and Worksop and Retford on 74.80%, up 1.50%. Mansfield has seen a marginal decrease of 0.90%, with an employment rating of 73.10%.




Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & Local Authority for most recent period




Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period





Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex




Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period




Figure 1: Employment Counts in Nottinghamshire





Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years

Figure 3: Employment Counts by Sex in Nottinghamshire (Exc. City)




Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Local Authority




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Parliamentary Constituency




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Travel to Work Area




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years






Figure 1: Claimants in Nottinghamshire

● Nottinghamshire ● Notts City ● Notts County





Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years




