I am writing to you in reply to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Nottinghamshire County Council about the number of School Crossing Patrols (SCP). I have the following information.

As SCP numbers fluctuate throughout the year we cannot give accurate figures on SCP numbers. The number of actual sites that we had is as follows:

2014: 139 sites

2015: 142 sites

2016: 142 sites

2017: 142 sites

2018: 143 sites

2019: 143 sites

As of today, we currently have 78 Patrols employed.

The number of hours that each SCP works will vary from site to site, dependent on the school times, number of schools served, distance from school etc. As an average we usually work on 0.15 FTE for a Patrol position.
