Claimant Counts

As of February 2020, the **Claimant Count** for the Nottinghamshire region is 1,150 higher than it was a month ago. This represents a rate of change of 5.10% over the month, which, in comparison to the East Midlands region, is 0.14% higher.

For the City of Nottingham, there is now a total of 10,385 claimants. In comparison, the County has 13,295, which is made up of 7,675 males and 5,620 females, a split of 57.73% to 42.27%.

The claimant count also increased in all seven Local Authority **Districts** in the region, over the month. The largest increase figure wise was in Mansfield, which saw a rise of 155 individuals, equalling a change of 7.09%. This is followed by Newark and Sherwood with an increase of 125 individuals, or 7.44%, and Gedling and Ashfield, both of which increased by 115 claimants (6.55% and 4.57% respectively).

Of the smaller increases, Bassetlaw rose by 60 individuals (3.05%), whilst the smallest increase was Rushcliffe, which saw a rise of only 30 individuals. Percentage wise, this represents a change of 2.97%.

Across the **Districts** gender wise, Ashfield has the greatest number of claimants with 2,630. This is broken down by 1,085 females and 1,545 males. The lowest is Rushcliffe with 1,035 claimants, made up of 440 females and 595 males.

As for the **Parliamentary Constituencies**, claimants increased in all eight during February. The largest was in Mansfield, with a rise of 155 over the previous month, representing a 7.09% growth. This is followed by Sherwood, which increased its claimant numbers by 110, or 7.24%.

Of the smaller increases, Broxtowe increased by only 45 individuals (3.66%), whilst the smallest increase occurred in Rushcliffe, which saw a rise of 20 individuals, equalling 2.29%.

Compared to a year ago, the rates of change across **Parliamentary Constituencies** range from 11.11% in Bassetlaw, to 58.41% in Rushcliffe. The average rate of change across all eight areas is 38.21%.

Additionally, against the previous month, all four of the **TTWA's** have increased their claimant numbers. Nottingham saw the largest growth, growing by 795 individuals, or 4.57%. This is followed by Lincoln, which increased by 350 claimants (5.65%), and Mansfield, which increased by 345 (6.14%).

The lowest growth over the month was in Worksop and Retford, where an increase of 50 claimants was seen, equalling a rise of 2.36%.

Of the Nottinghamshire **Wards**, Oak Tree, which is within the Mansfield district, continues to have the highest percentile of claimants with 163 individuals, representing 8.40% of its 16-64 workforce population.

Comparatively, Tollerton, within the Rushcliffe district, has the lowest rate. Here there are only 5 claimants, or 0.20% of its 16-64 workforce population.

Employment Counts

Due to the employment figures being updated on a quarterly basis, these remain unchanged for **February 2020**.

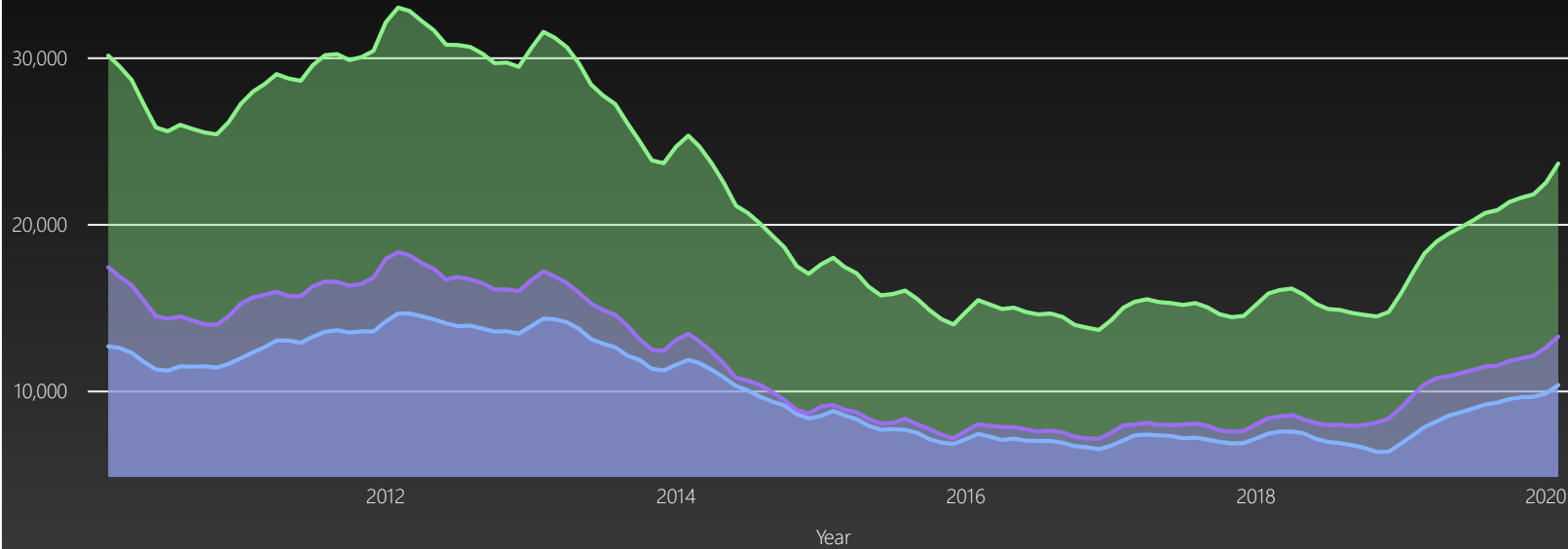
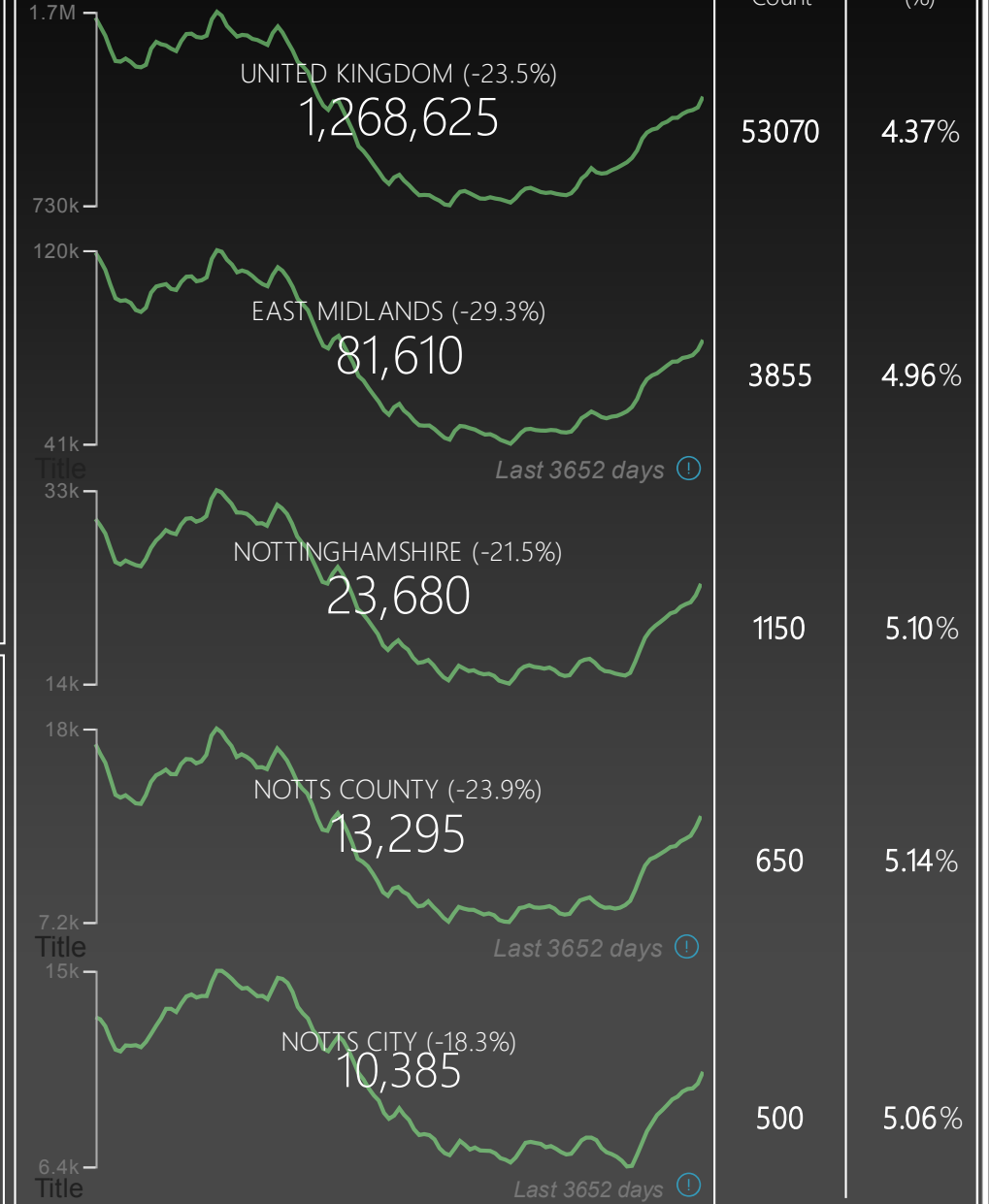


Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years

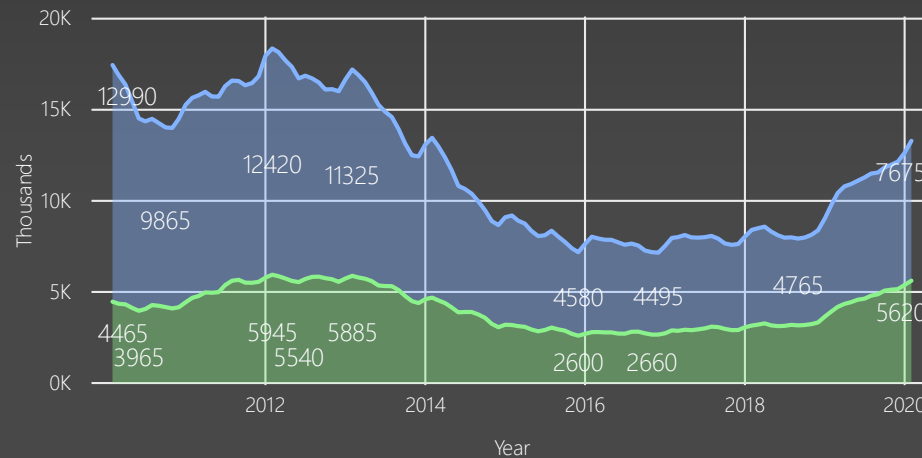

Figure 1: Claimants by District

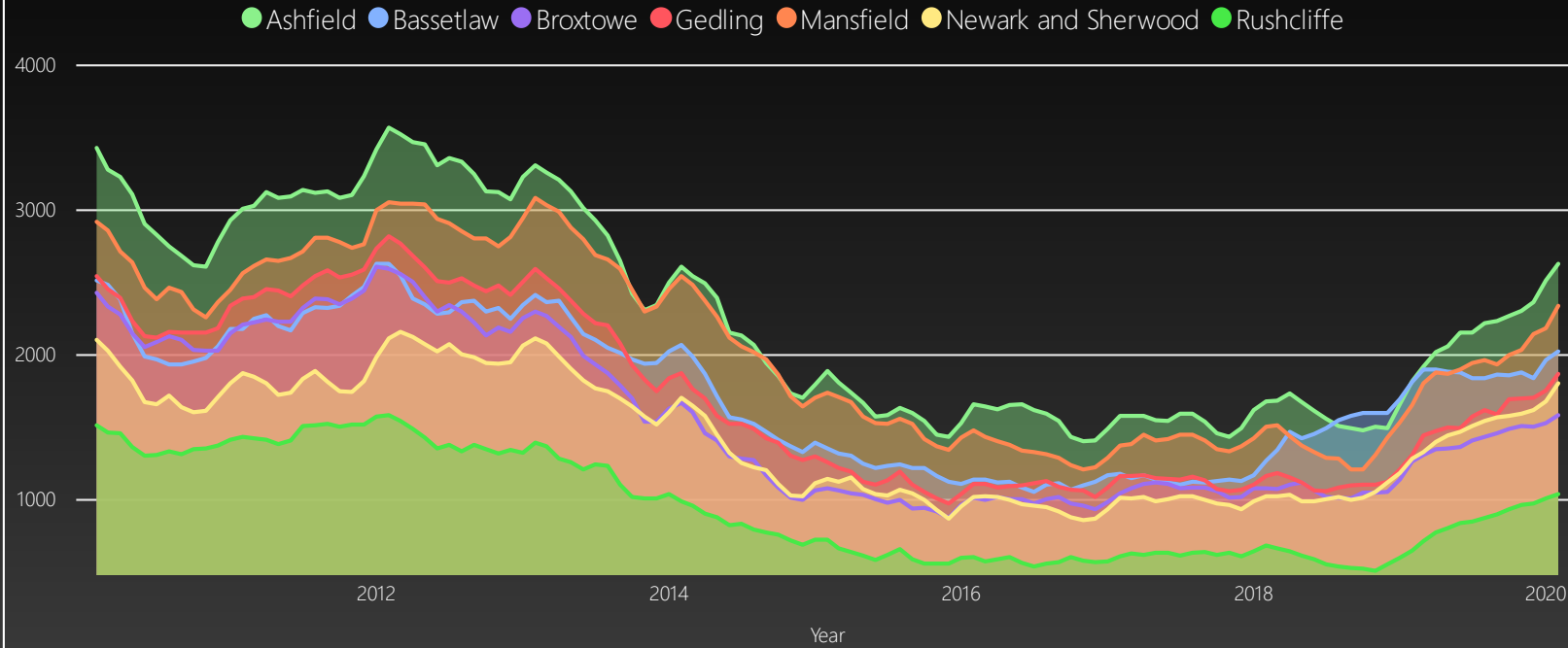


Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & Local Authority for most recent period

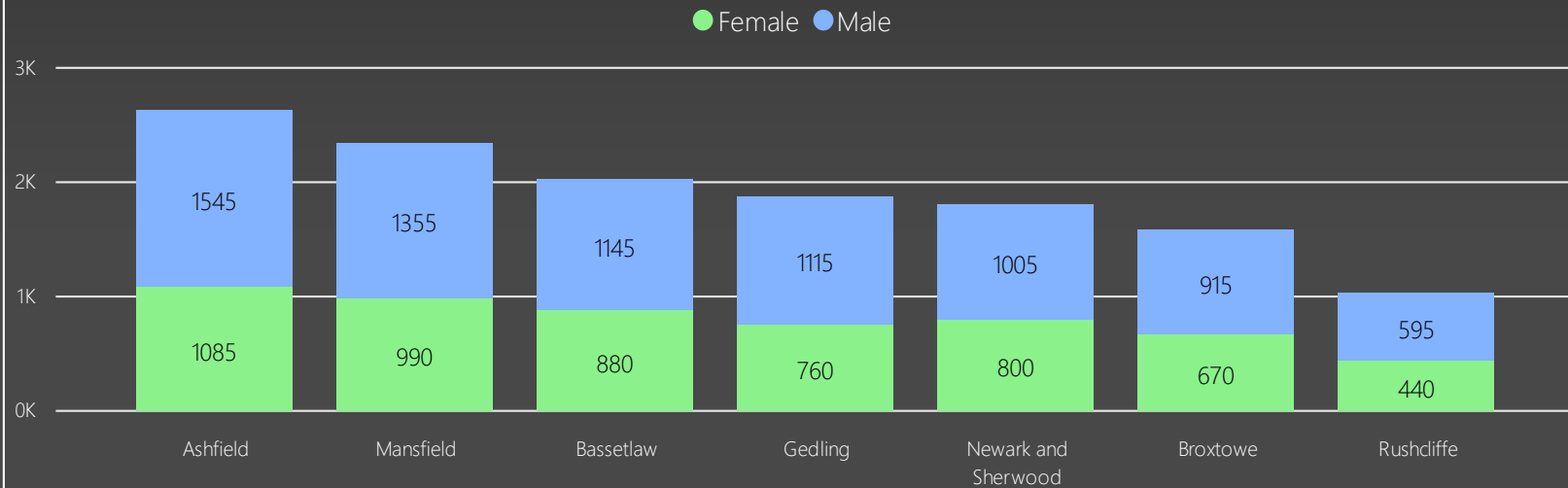


Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years

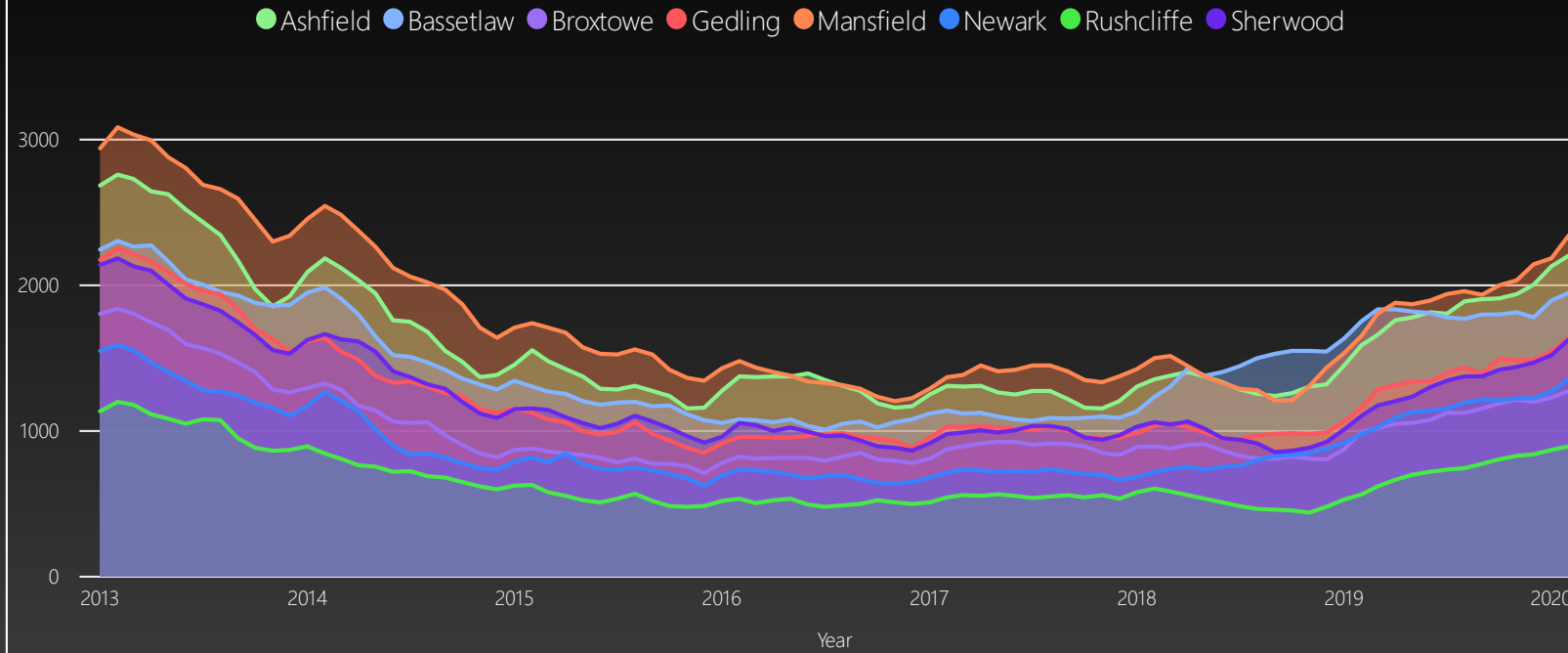


Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period

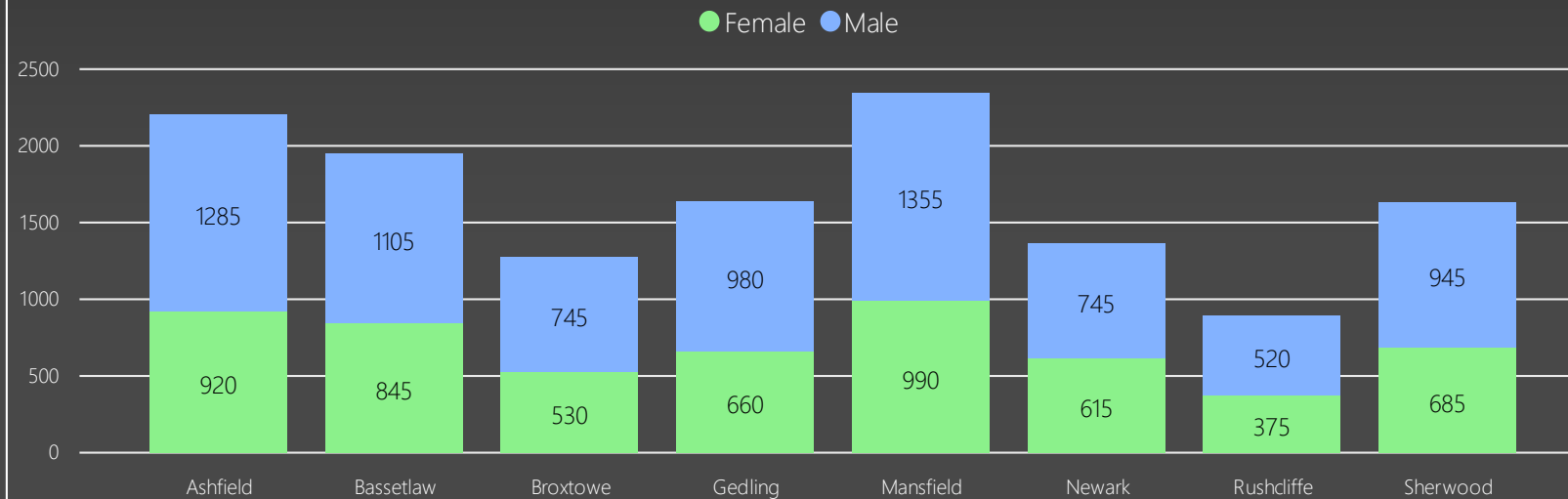
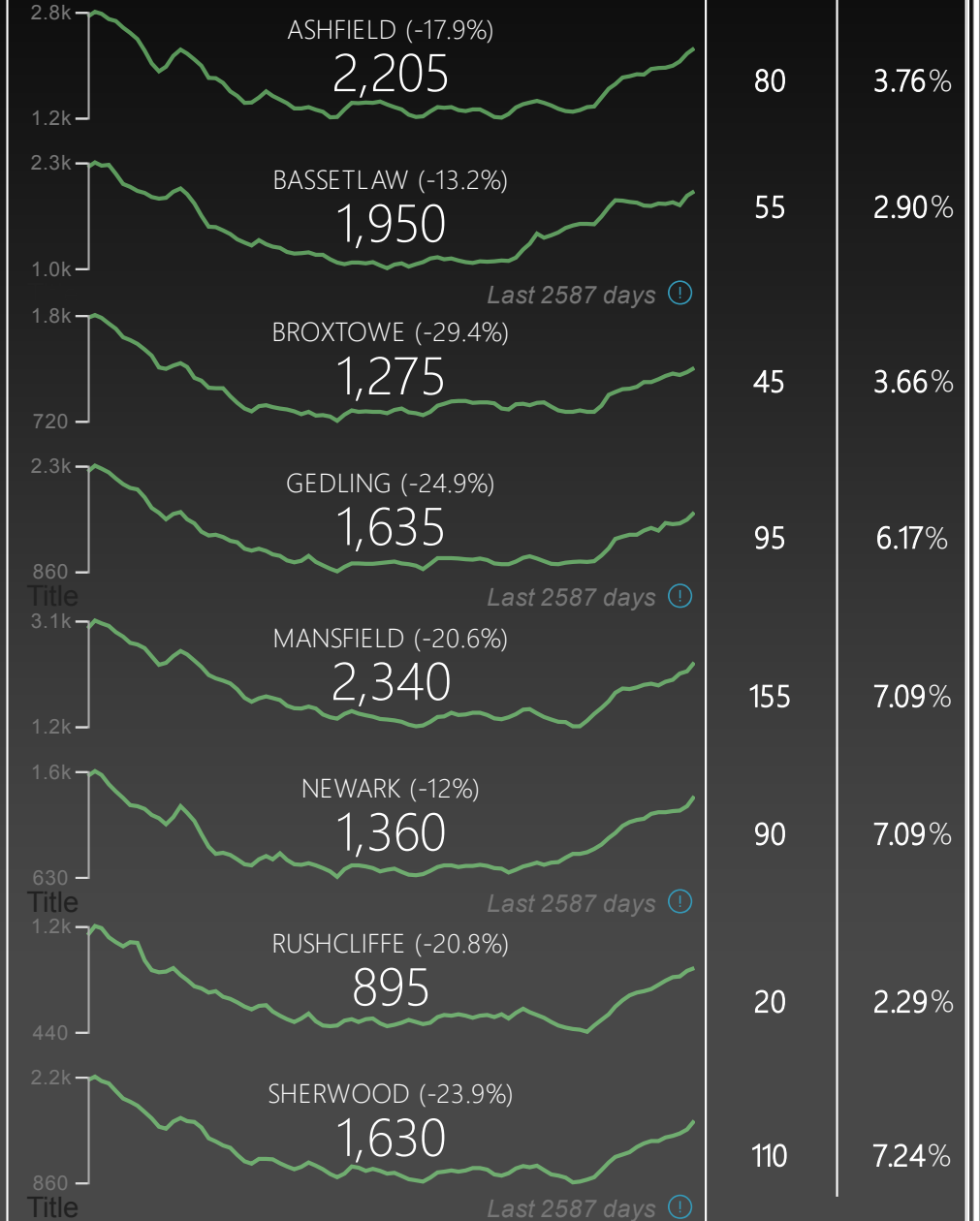


Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire

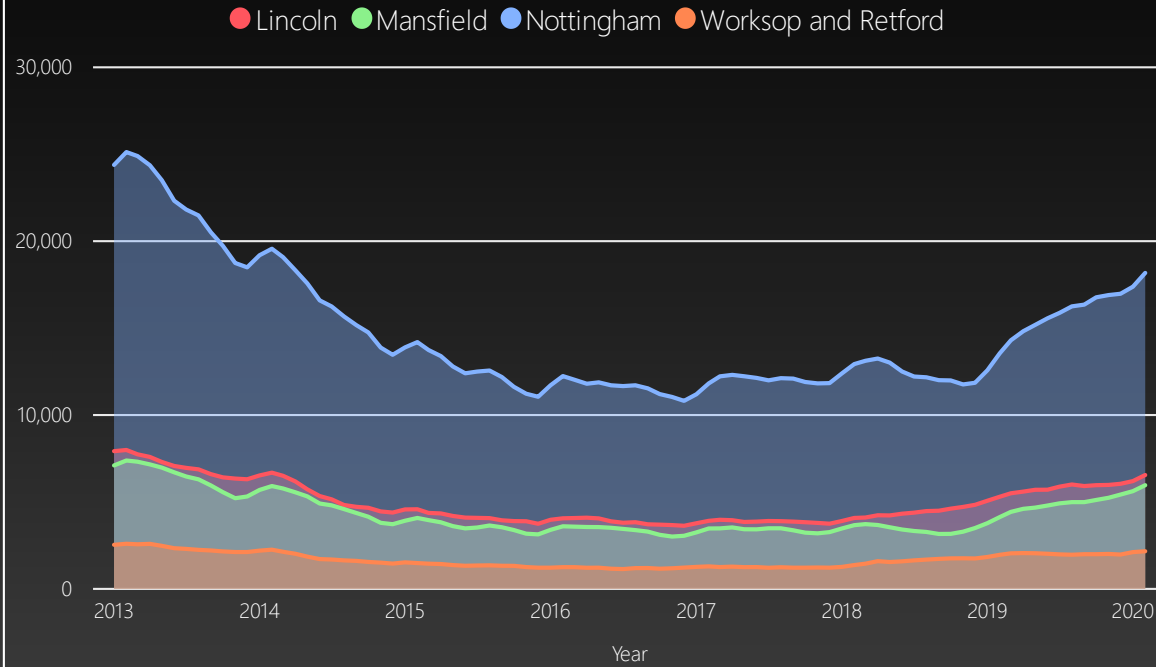


Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex

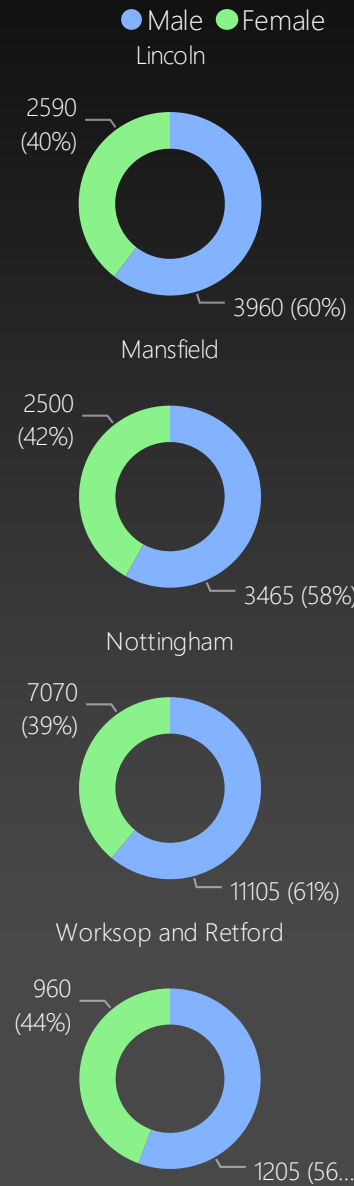


Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years

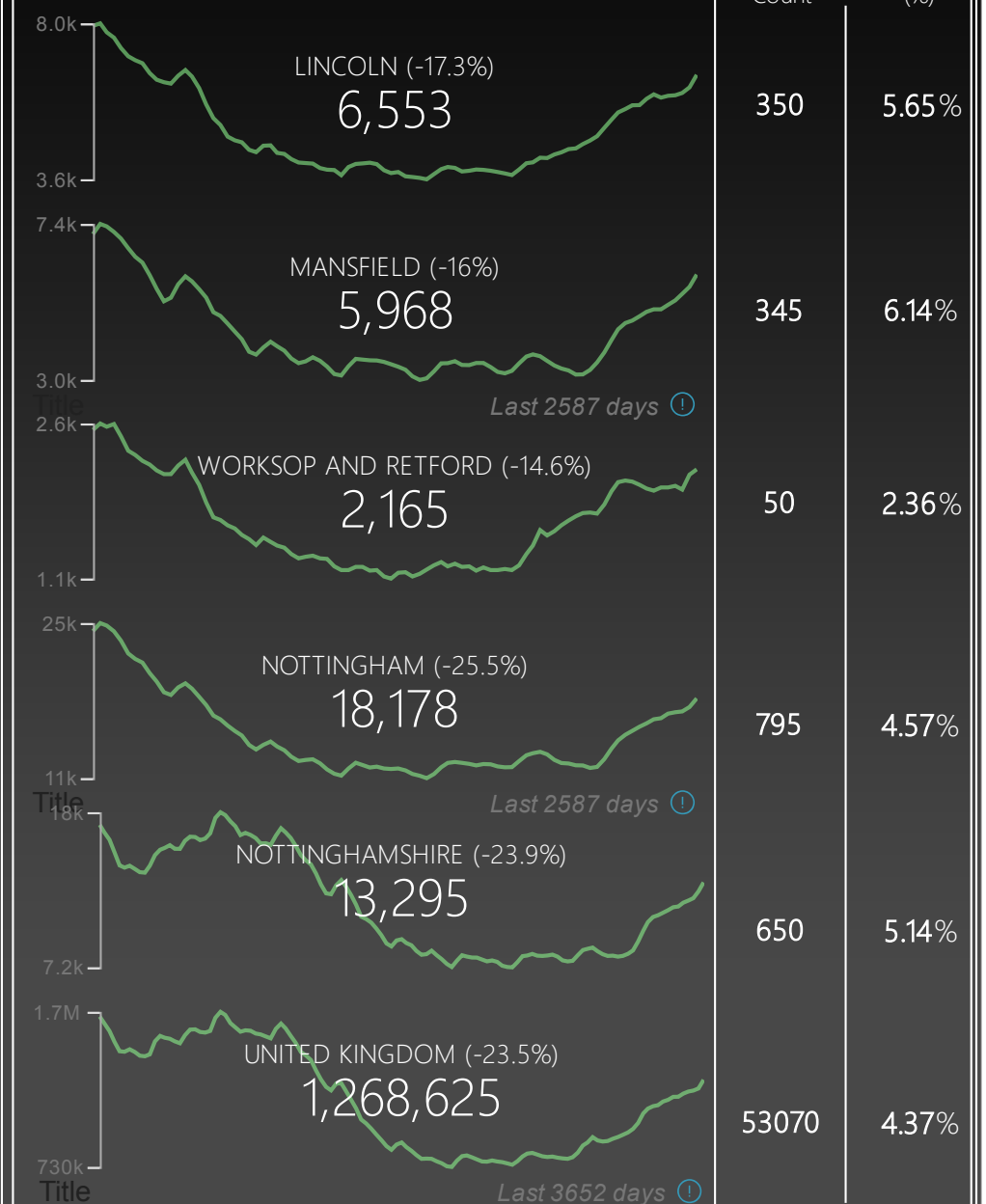


Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period

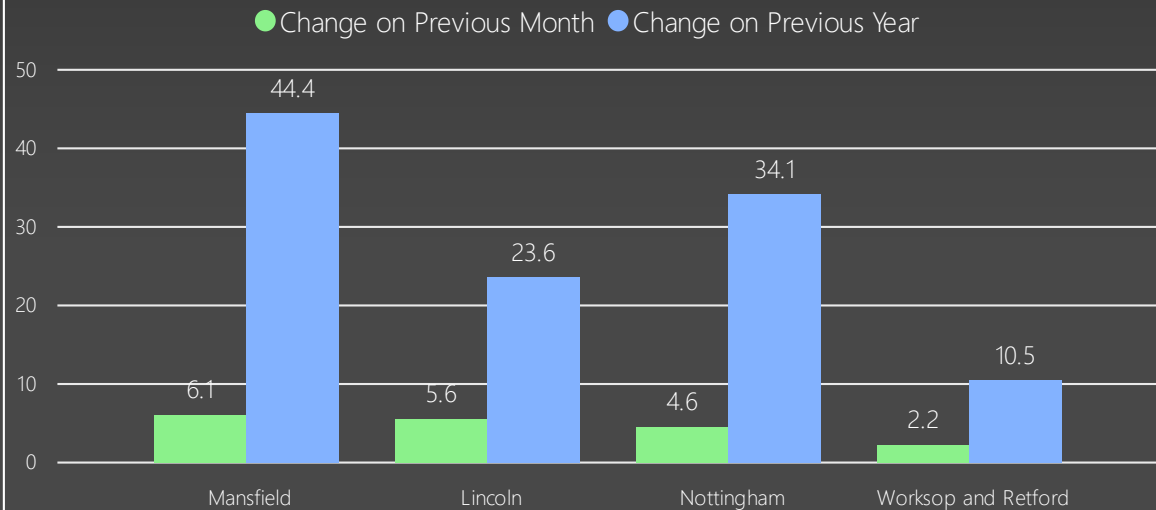




Figure 1: Employment Counts in Nottinghamshire

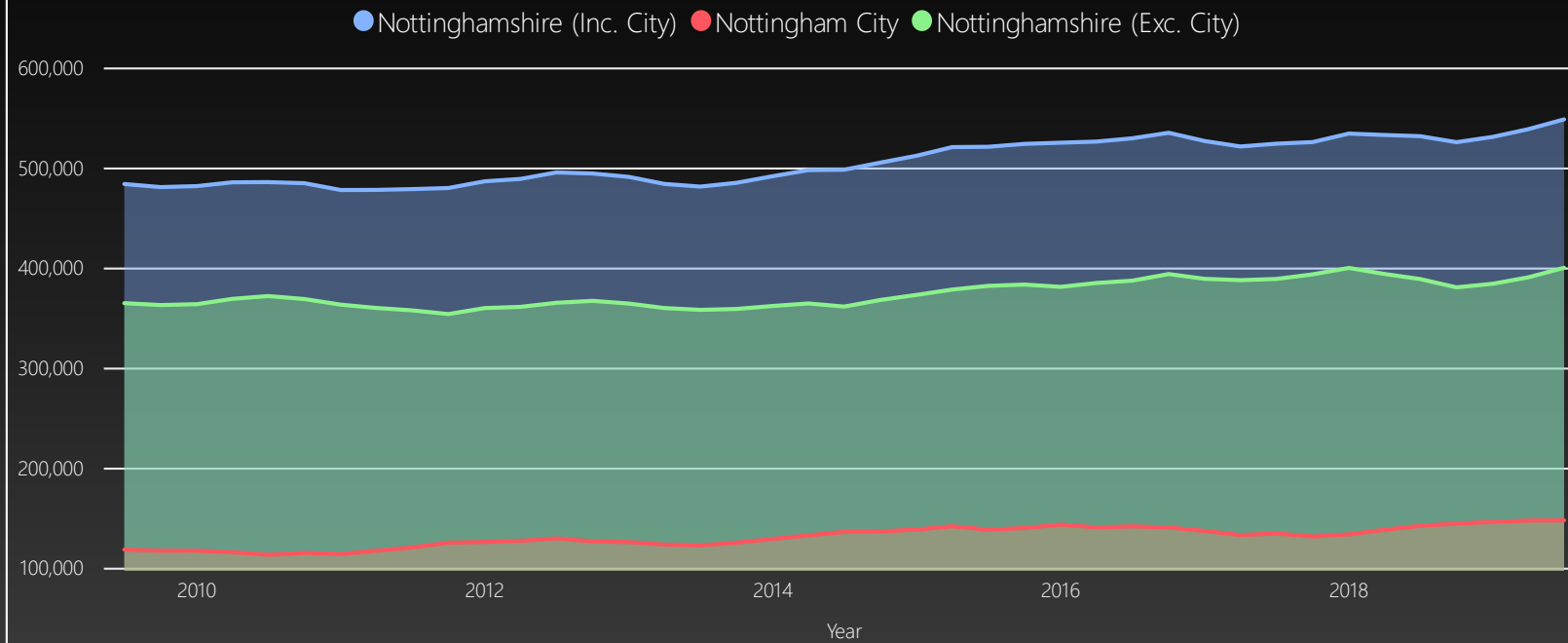
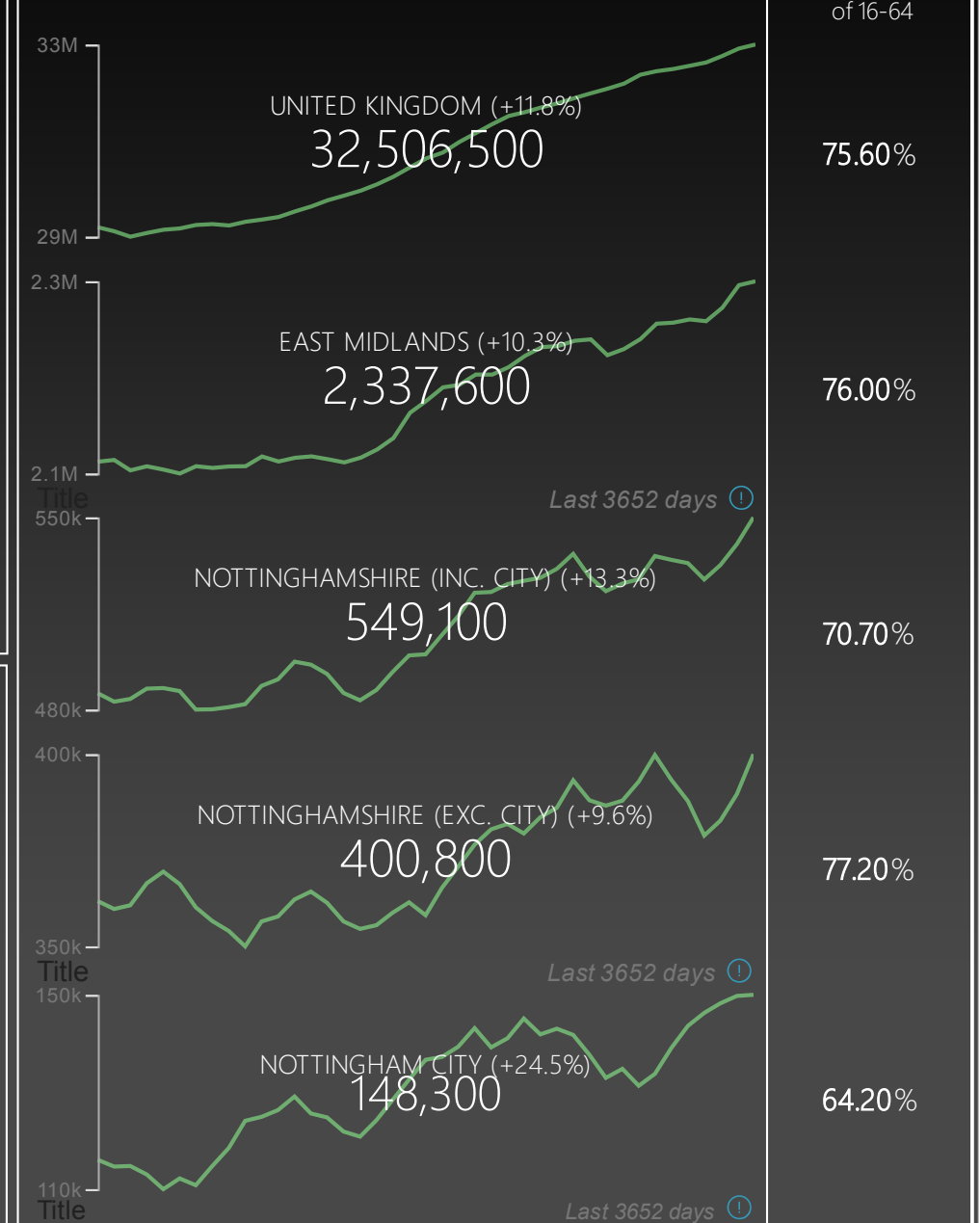


Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years

Figure 3: Employment Counts by Sex in Nottinghamshire (Exc. City)

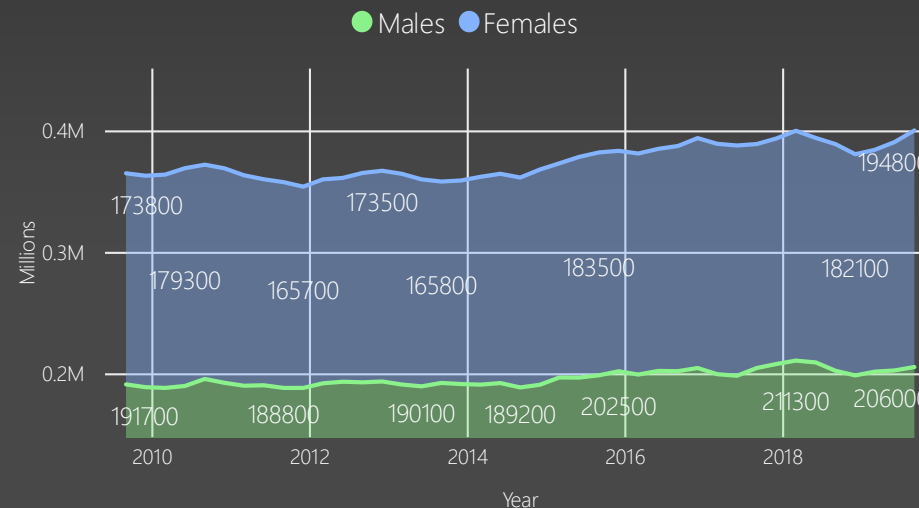


Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64

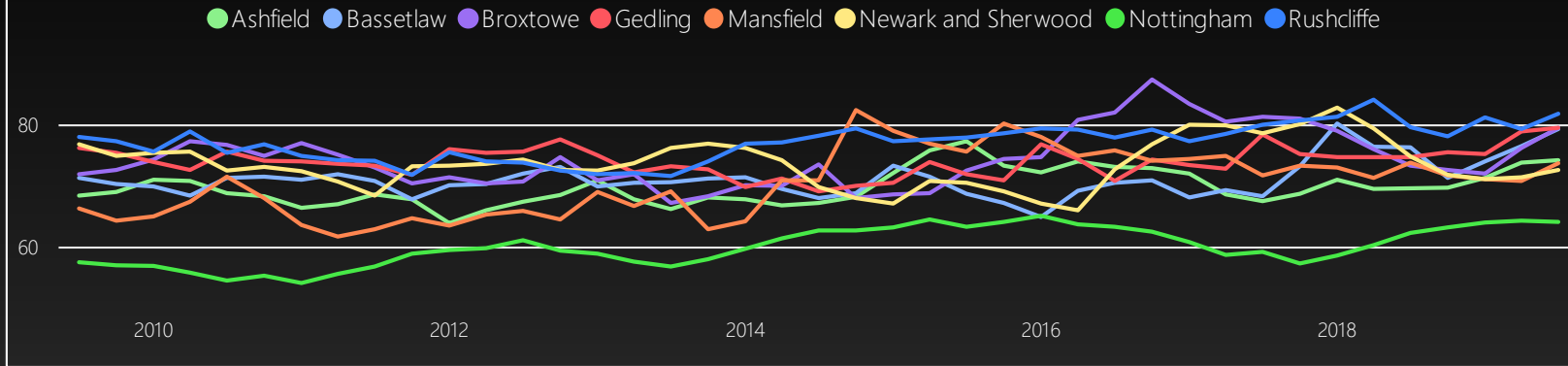


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Local Authority

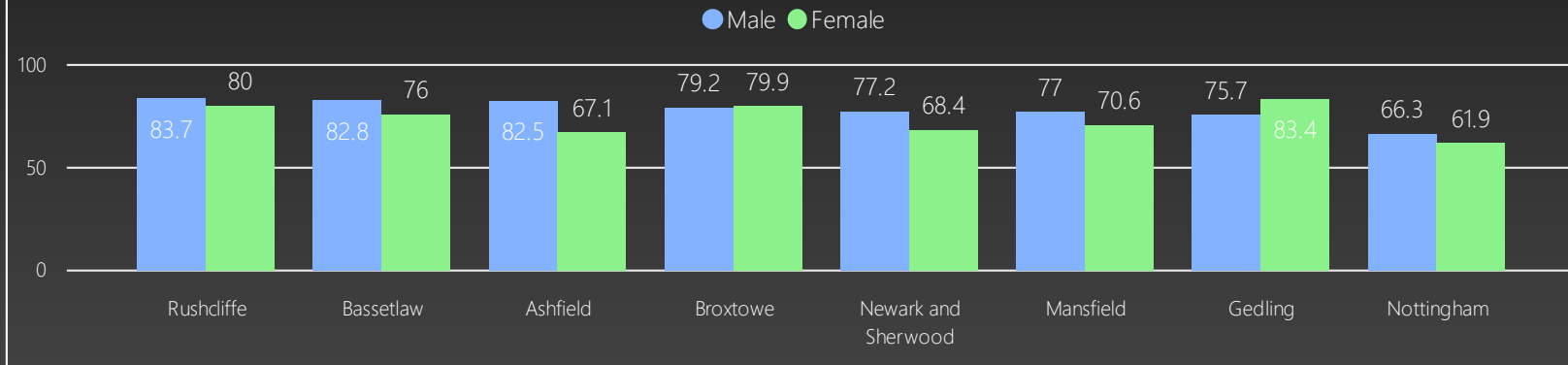


Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type

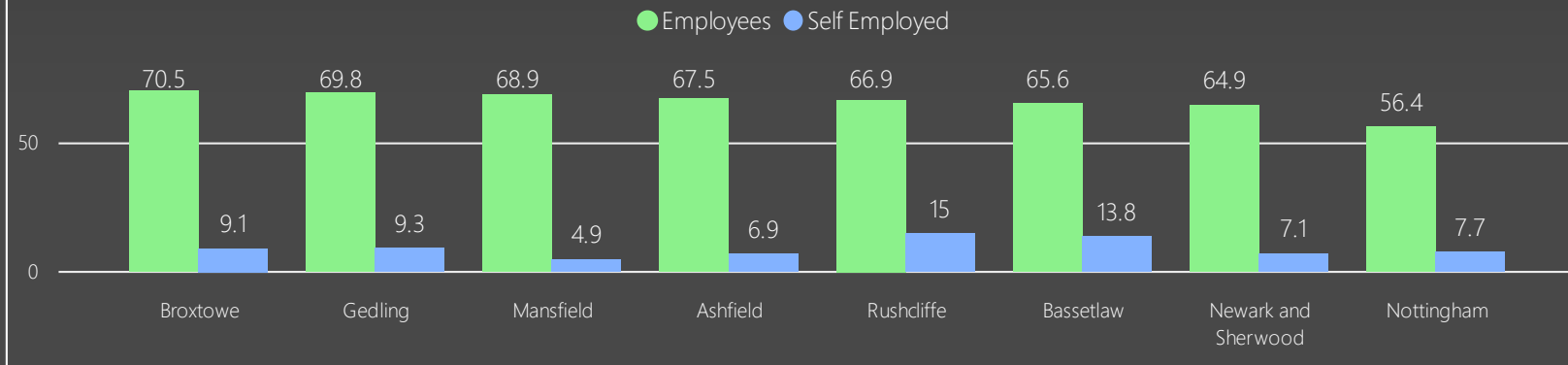


Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years

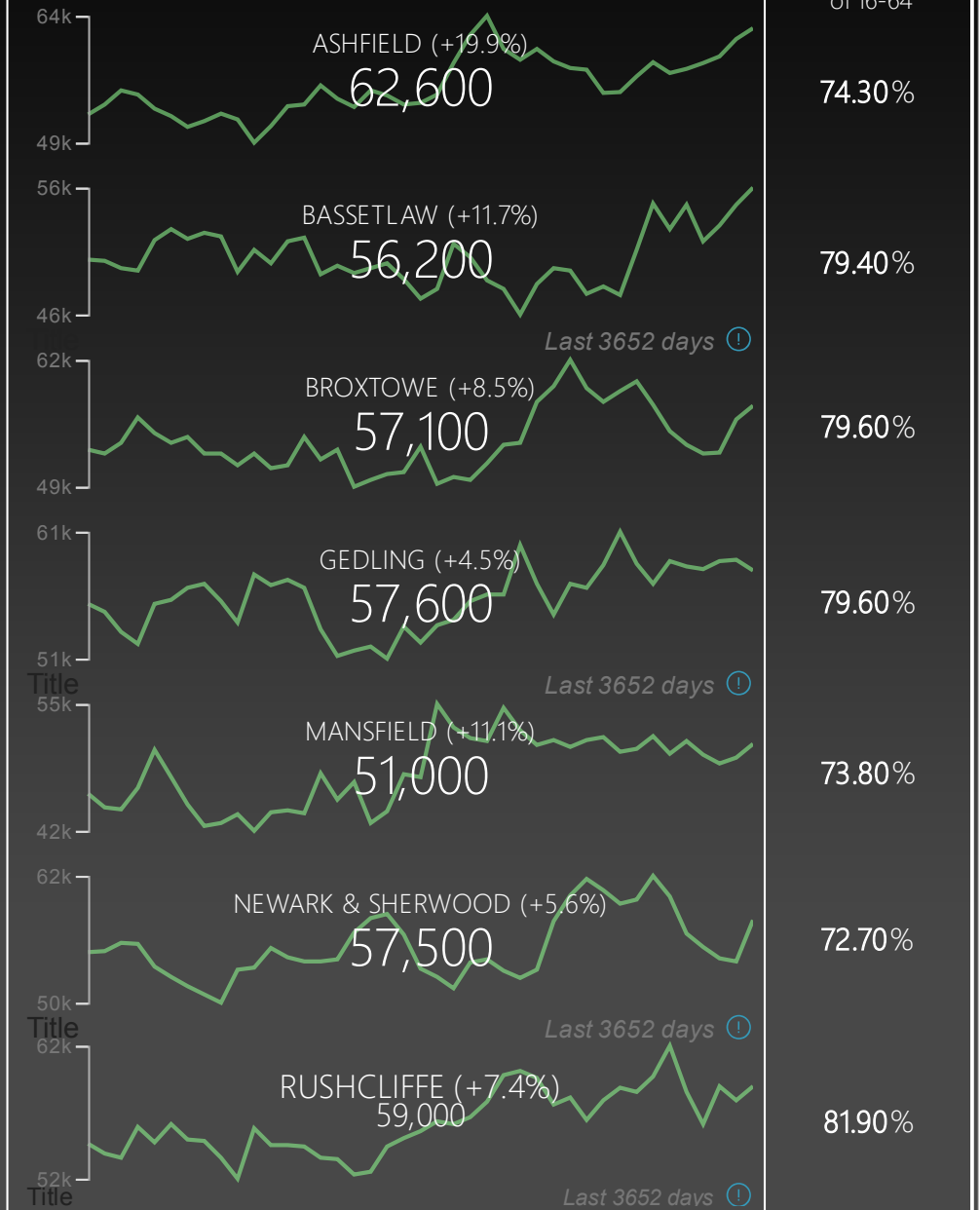


Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64

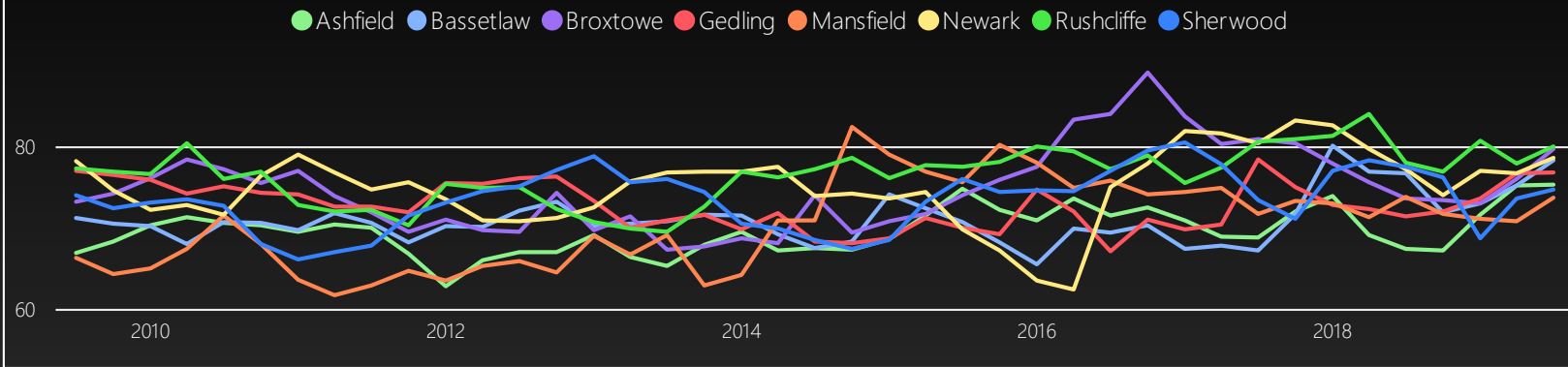


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Parliamentary Constituency

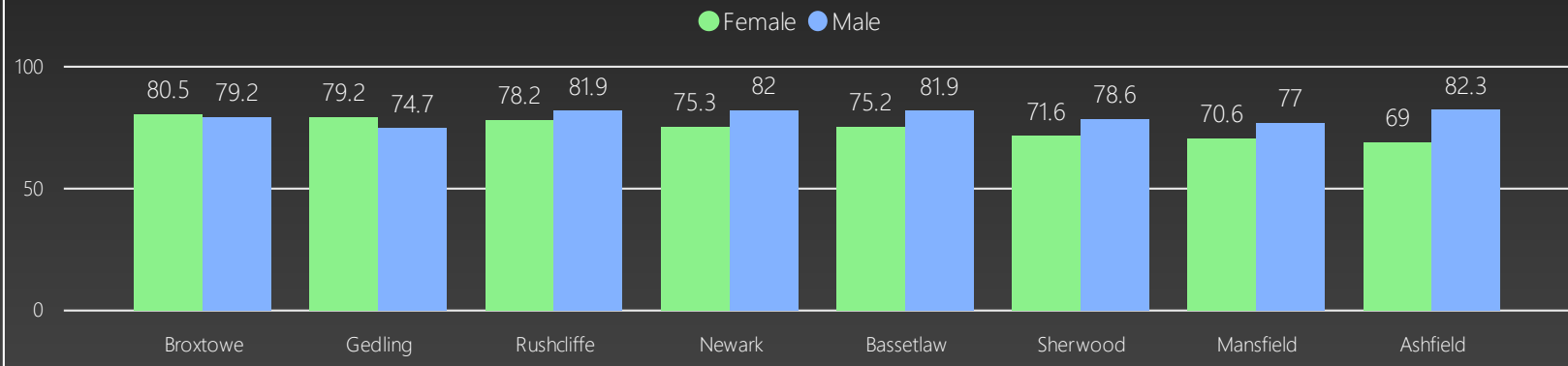


Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type

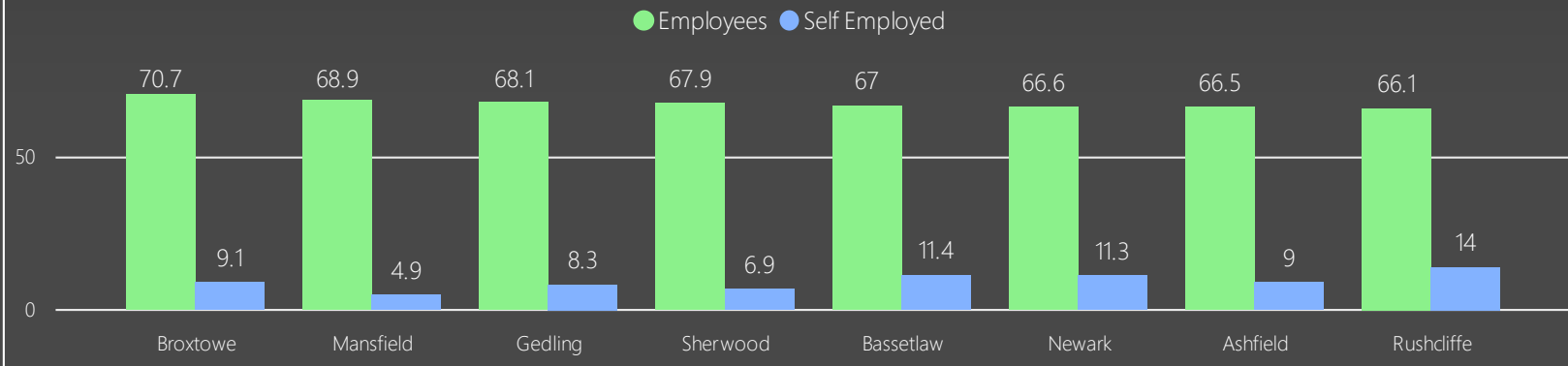


Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years

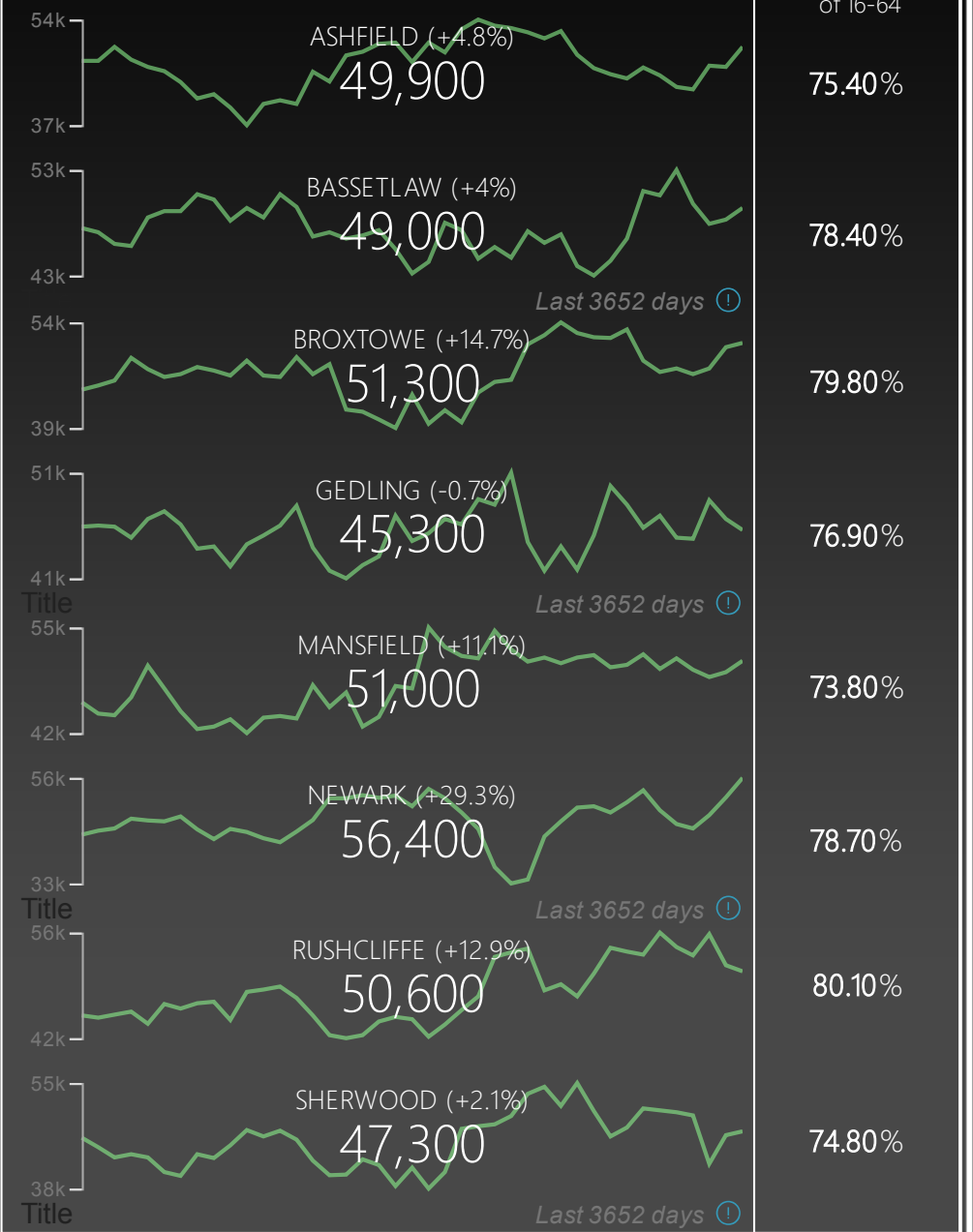


Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64

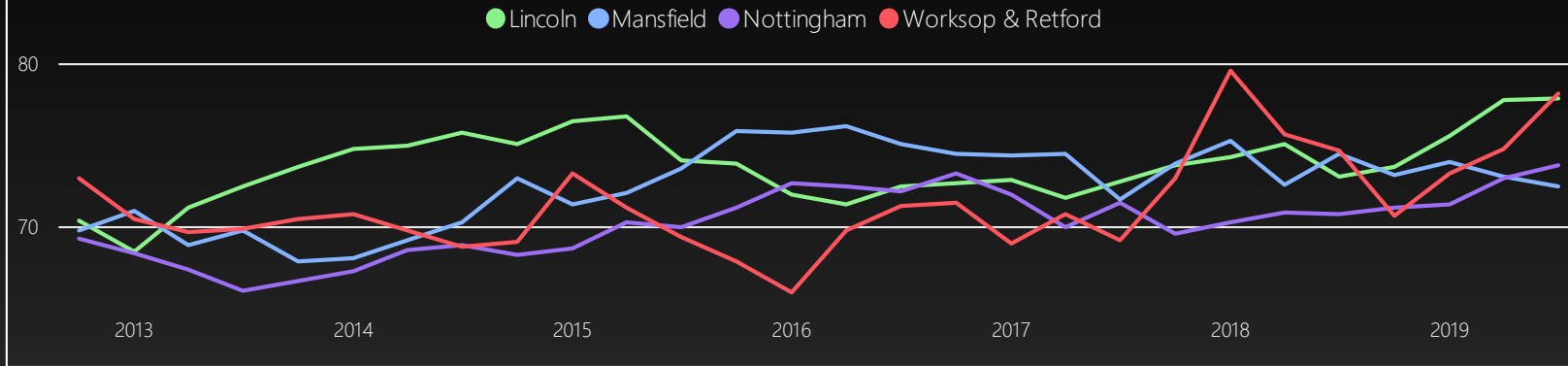


Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years

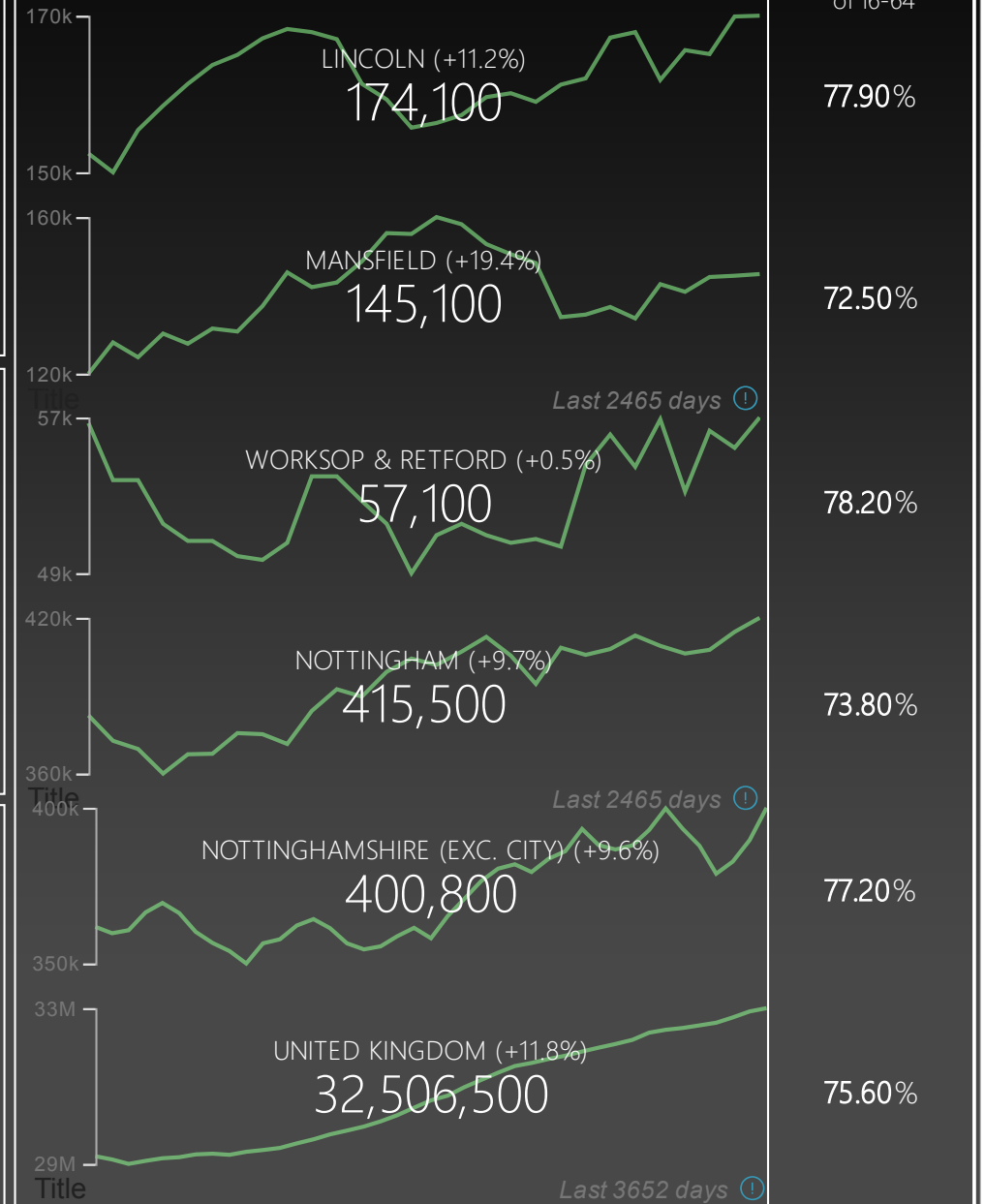


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Travel to Work Area

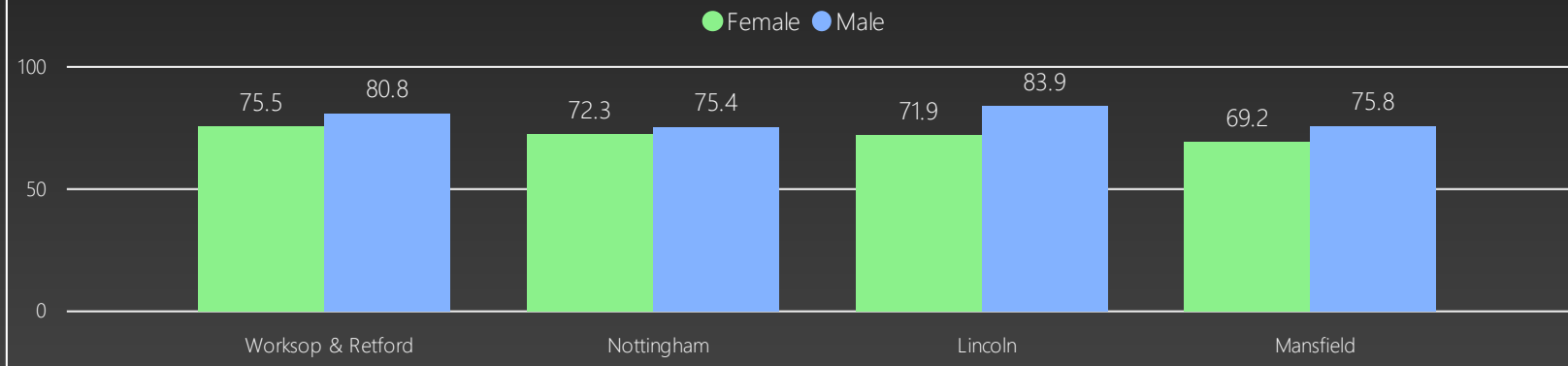
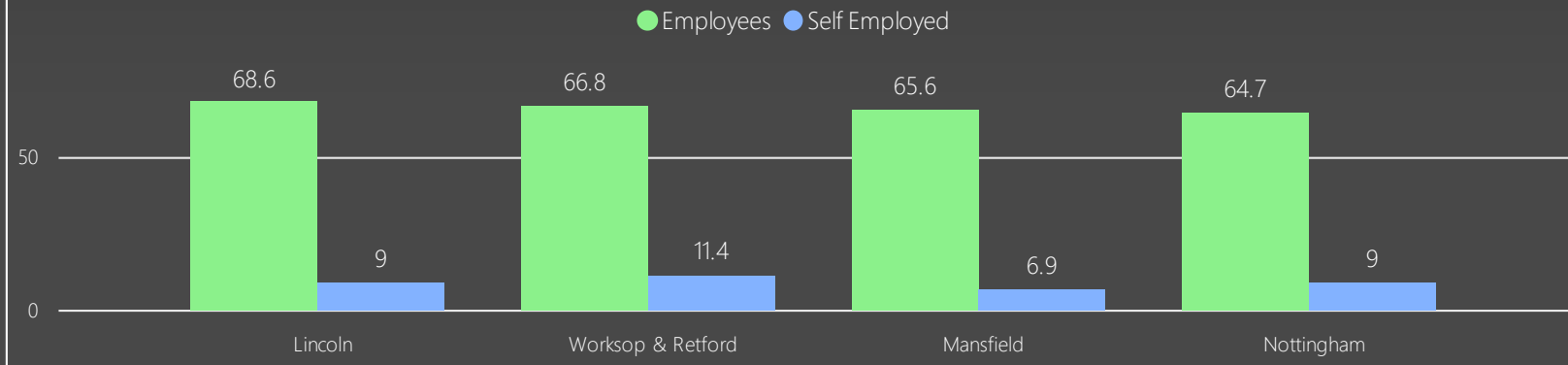
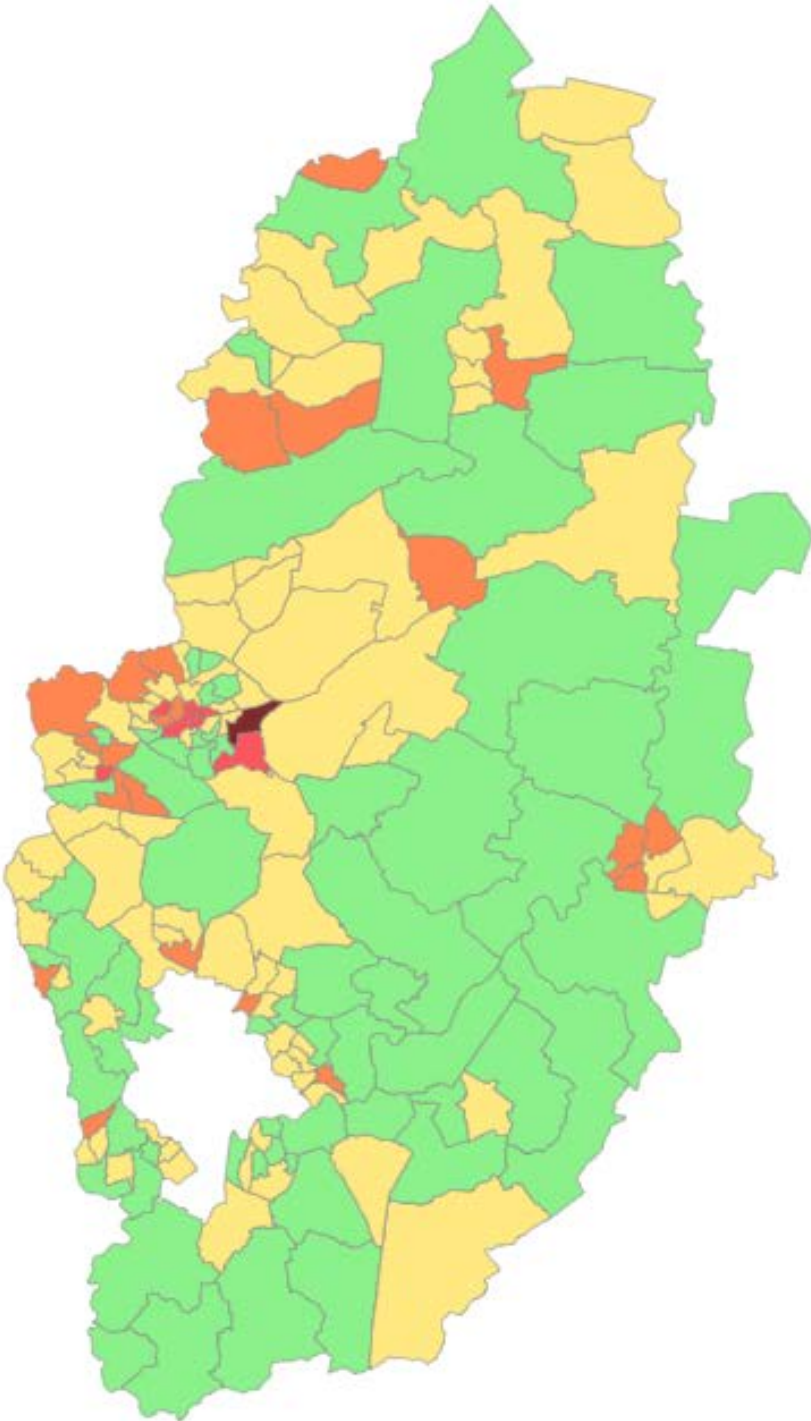


Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type
