Universal Credit

For the previous month of March 2020, the total number of **Universal Credit** Claimants in Nottinghamshire now stands at 31,040 individuals.

This represents a change of 4.10% in comparison to February, and is broken up by 7,566 employed females, 10,254 unemployed females, 4,005 employed males and 9,215 unemployed males.

Claimant Counts

As of April 2020, the **Claimant Count** for the Nottinghamshire region is 13,215 higher than it was a month ago. This represents a rate of change of 56.56% over the month, though in comparison to the East Midlands region, this is 12.13% lower.

For Nottingham City, there is now a total of 14,370 claimants. In comparison, the County has 22,210, the shire has 36,580, the East Midlands region has 136,280 and the total across the UK is 2,117,360.

The claimant count also increased in all seven Local Authority **Districts**, over the month. The largest increase figure wise was in Ashfield, which saw a rise of 1,795 individuals, equalling a change of 69.84%.

The smallest increase was seen in Rushcliffe, which saw a rise of 880 individuals. However, this was the greatest increase percentage wise, with a change totalling 85.44%.

Across the **Districts** gender wise, Ashfield has the greatest number of claimants with 4,365. This is broken down by 1,710 females and 2,655 males. The lowest is Rushcliffe with 1,910 claimants, made up of 785 females and 1,125 males.

As for the **Parliamentary Constituencies**, claimants increased in all eight during April. Of these, Mansfield now has the greatest total number of claimants, with 3,785 individuals. This is followed by Ashfield with 3,710 individuals and Bassetlaw with 3,220 individuals. Rushcliffe currently has the smallest total number of claimants, with 1,645.

Compared to a year ago, the rates of change across **Parliamentary Constituencies** range from 75.48% in Bassetlaw, to 147.37% in Rushcliffe. The average rate of change across all eight areas is 110.25%.

Additionally, against the previous month, all four of the **TTWA's** have increased their claimant numbers. Nottingham saw the largest growth, growing by 9,380 individuals, or 52.07%. This is followed by Mansfield, which increased by 4,160 claimants (71.42%), and Lincoln, which increased by 4,130 (64.68%).

The lowest growth over the month figure wise was in Worksop and Retford, where an increase of 1,540 claimants was seen, equalling a rise of 75.12%.

As for gender, the **TTWA's** with the greatest percentage of male claimants are Lincoln and Nottingham, both with 62% (6,495 and 16,920 respectively). Whilst Mansfield and Worksop and Retford have the greatest percentage of female claimants, with 40% each (3,950 and 1,430).

Employment Counts

As the employment figures are updated on a quarterly basis, these remain unchanged for **April**.

The number of Universal Credit claimants includes those who have started Universal Credit (completed the Universal Credit claim process and accepted their Claimant Commitment) and have not had a closure of their claim recorded for this spell

Figure 1: Universal Credit Claimants in Nottinghamshire by Employment Status




Figure 3: Universal Credit Claimants in Nottinghamshire by Employment Status and Sex





Figure 2: UC Claimant count changes over last year





Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Claimants by District




Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & Local Authority for most recent period




Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period





Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex




Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years






Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period

Figure 3: Employment Counts by Sex in Nottinghamshire (Exc. City)




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Local Authority




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




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


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Parliamentary Constituency




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


Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




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


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Travel to Work Area




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




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years
