Universal Credit

For the previous month of April 2020, the total number of **Universal Credit** Claimants in Nottinghamshire now stands at 45,059 individuals.

This represents a change of 45.15% in comparison to March, and is broken up by approximately 10,626 employed females, 13,424 unemployed females, 6,532 employed males and 14,478 unemployed males.

Claimant Counts

As of May 2020, the **Claimant Count** for the Nottinghamshire region is 8,750 higher than it was a month ago, which represents a rate of change of 23.99%. In comparison the East Midlands regions monthly change stands at 26.20%.

For Nottingham City, there is now a total of 17,775 claimants. In comparison, the County has 27,445, the Shire has 45,220, the East Midlands region has 171,740 and the total across the UK is 2,675,250.

The claimant count also increased in all seven Local Authority **Districts**, over the month. The largest increase figure wise was in Mansfield, which saw a rise of 915 individuals, equalling a change of 24.17%.

The smallest increase was seen in Bassetlaw, which saw a rise of 560 individuals. This represents a percentile increase of 16.45% over the month.

Across the **Districts** gender wise, Ashfield has the greatest number of claimants with 5,180. This is broken down by 1,950 females and 3,230 males. The lowest is Rushcliffe with 2,510 claimants, made up of 1,020 females and 1,490 males.

As for the **Parliamentary Constituencies**, claimants increased in all eight during May. Of these, Mansfield continues to have the greatest total number of claimants, with 4,700 individuals, which is followed by Ashfield with 4,375 individuals. Rushcliffe has the smallest total number of claimants, with 2,150.

Compared to a year ago, the rates of change across **Parliamentary Constituencies** range from 106.59% in Bassetlaw, to 207.14% in Rushcliffe. The average rate of change across all eight areas is 157.47%.

Additionally, against the previous month, all four of the **TTWA's** have increased their claimant numbers. Nottingham saw the largest growth, increasing by 6,780 individuals, or 24.85%. This is followed by Mansfield, which grew by 2,065 claimants (20.67%), and Lincoln, which increased by 1,955 (18.61%).

The lowest growth over the month figure wise was in Worksop and Retford, where an increase of 590 claimants was seen, equalling a rise of 16.34%.

As for gender, the **TTWA's** with the greatest percentage of male claimants are Lincoln and Nottingham, both with 63% (7,830 and 21,375 respectively). Worksop and Retford has the greatest percentage of female claimants, with 40% (1,665).

Of the Nottinghamshire **Wards**, Newgate has the highest percentage of claimants with 267 individuals (12% of its 16-64 aged workforce population). Lowdham has the lowest percentile rate, 2.30% of its 16-64 aged workforce population (57 claimants).

Figure 1: Universal Credit Claimants in Nottinghamshire by Employment Status




Figure 3: Universal Credit Claimants in Nottinghamshire by Employment Status and Sex





Figure 2: UC Claimant count changes over last year





Figure 2: Claimant count changes over last 10 years






Figure 3: Claimants by Sex & Local Authority for most recent period




Figure 2: District claimant count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Parliamentary Constituencies and Sex for most recent period





Figure 2: Parliamentary Constituencies claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 1: Claimant Count by Travel To Work Areas in Nottinghamshire




Figure 4: Unemployment change in TTWA's for most recent period




Figure 3: Claimant Count by Travel to Work Areas in Nottinghamshire by sex






Figure 3: TTWA claimant count changes over last 10 years

Figure 3: Employment Counts by Sex in Nottinghamshire (Exc. City)




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Local Authority




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years




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


Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Parliamentary Constituency




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type




Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years



Figure 1: Percentage in employment of 16-64




Figure 3: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by Sex & Travel to Work Area




Figure 4: Percentage in employment of 16-64 for most recent period by employment type









Figure 2: Employment count changes over last 10 years
