## Dear

I am writing to you in reply to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Nottinghamshire County Council. I have the following information.

- 1). The current speed limit on the A610 Eastwood By-Pass, Kimberley, Nottingham is 50mph. However, this was changed from 70mph please confirm the date the speed limit was changed. The Order for the 50mph limit on the A610 was made on 14th February 2005. (Copy attached).
- 2). What was the reason for the change in speed limit.

  The speed limit was introduced to reduce the number, likelihood, and severity of road traffic accidents.
- *3).* Has there been any serious incidents since the change of speed limit to 50mph. There have been 2 fatal and 7 serious reported injury accidents on that 50mph section of the A610 on the main carriageway (excluding slip roads and roundabout) in the period 14/2/2005 to 31/1/2020.
