## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

# The Nottinghamshire County Council (A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass, Nuthall to Giltbrook) (40 & 50 MPH Speed Limits) Order 2005 (5082)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on those lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (A610
  Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass, Nuthall to Giltbrook) (40 & 50 MPH Speed Limits) Order 2005"
  and shall come into force on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 2005.

#### SCHEDULE 1

#### Lengths of road at Nuthall and Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe

- A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass, Nuthall from a point 13.5 metres west of the outer kerbline of the A6002/A610 Nuthall island roundabout, in a westerly direction to a point 14 metres east of the outer kerbline of the M1 Junction 26 roundabout, an approximate distance of 576 metres;
- 2. A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass, Kimberley from a point 29 metres west of the outer kerbline of the M1 Junction 26 roundabout in a westerly direction to a point 119 metres east of the centre line of the High Street Overbridge, an approximate distance of 1,288 metres:
- 3. Nottingham Road, Kimberley from its junction with the A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass in a northerly direction to a point 71 metres south of its junction with Kimberley Road as measured along the centre line of the road.

#### SCHEDULE 2

#### Lengths of road at Awsworth and Giltbrook in the Borough of Broxtowe

- 1. A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass, Giltbrook from a point 119 metres east of the centre line of the High Street Overbridge in westerly direction to a point 168 metres east of the centre line of the Greasley Footpath No. 53 subway, an approximate distance of 2,466 metres;
- 2. B6010 Nottingham Road, Giltbrook from the outer kerbline of its roundabout junction with the A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass in a northerly direction for a distance of 138 metres as measured along the centre line of the central reservation;
- 3. A6096 Gin Close Way, Awsworth from its junction with the A610 Kimberley/Eastwood Bypass in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
