I am writing to you in reply to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Nottinghamshire County Council.

You requested copies of all the completed and published Domestic Homicide Reviews in your council district where the victim was male, and the perpetrator was female for the period February 2019 to August 2020.

The county council doesn't hold the DHR reports, however these reports are published on the website of the relevant District/Borough Council after they have been agreed with the Home Office. The DHR's are the responsibility of the Community Safety Partnerships which are coordinated by the District/Borough Councils, hence their websites are used for publication. But these reports, at the right time in terms of the contents being agreed and any criminal processes completed, are put in the public domain.
