Appendix A illustrates the termly projection of the number of children that will receive funded hours based on trend data from 2019/20. The forecast shows how the fluctuations in the number of funded children cause the forecast underspend to occur. The 'dip' in number of funded places that occurs in the Autumn term is due to eligibility i.e. more and more children become eligible for their entitlement throughout the academic year (three year olds are eligible the term after they turn three), before a large proportion enter schools in the Autumn term.
