Dear Requester,

Further to your request for information under the Freedom Of Information Act, please find attached the results of traffic flow and speed surveys undertaken in Ragnall. The location of the traffic counters is shown below.



You might be interested to know about some of our recent engineering projects to improve road safety in that area; a signing/road markings scheme for the bends at Farhill Lane was completed in August 2018 (and the surface itself was improved around the same time at that location), and we have an active project for reduced speed limits on the A57 from Darlton to Dunham which should be delivered this financial year.

We trust this now resolves your enquiry and where we have not been able to provide details we expect that this information is not held by Nottinghamshire county Council at this time.

We suggest all requesters search under our publication scheme in advance of requesting information under the freedom of information act.

I am writing to make a freedom of information request for details of all accidents and adverse events related to the road through Ragnall, Main Street NG22 0UR and within a 1 mile radius including the junction with the A57.

I would grateful if you could include any information relating to speed observations and requests within Ragnall Village.

I have been a resident in Ragnall for 7 years and have seen neighbours property damaged in many occasions due to vehicles leaving the road, there has also historically been a pedestrian death in this road. All neighbouring villages have a lower speed limit of 30 mph while the limit through Ragnall is 40 mph. I have canvassed residents and am confident the majority of residents feel the same way.
