

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MANSFIELD BRIDLEWAY NO.26, BLACK SCOTCH LANE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall:-

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed and
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of bridleway at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield: -

<u>Mansfield Bridleway No. 26, Black Scotch Lane</u> between the A617 at grid reference point SK 5570 5829 and Lindhurst West Way at SK 5559 5854, a distance of 280 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From Monday, 30th November 2020 until Monday, 31st May 2021 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be on shared user roadside path.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable aproved construction work either side of the bridleway and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the path.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
