HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CLAYWORTH FOOTPATH NO.3) DIVERSION ORDER 2020

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Bassetlaw District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Clayworth and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up upon certification of the newly created section of path as described in part 2 of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a footpath over the land situate at Clayworth described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7255 8854, at the junction with the remainder of Clayworth Footpath No 3, and proceeding for a distance of approximately 180 metres in a generally north-north-easterly direction to a point SK 7258 8872, the remainder of Clayworth Footpath No.3.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7255 8854, at the junction with the remainder of Clayworth Footpath No.3 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 119 metres, to a point, SK 7264 8862, then continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for a further 119 metres, to a point, SK 7258 8872, the remainder of Clayworth Footpath No.3 and having a total diverted length of 238 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout the diversion and on a grass surface, between points SK 7255 8854 and SK 7258 8872.
