(2) MODIFICATION ORDER (2014)

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Nottinghamshire (Ashfield District) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (b) of the Act, namely the expiration of a period such that the enjoyment by the public of the ways during that period raises a presumption that the ways have been dedicated as public footpaths over land situated at Kirkby in Ashfield and Annesley.

The Authority have consulted with every Local Authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates.

The Nottinghamshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1st January 2014.
2. The Nottinghamshire (Ashfield District) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Kirkby in Ashfield Footpath No. 89/Annesley Footpath No. 20) Modification Order (2014)".
