

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOWPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MISTERTON TOWPATH, LOCKS 63 AND 64) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall:-

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed and
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of Towpath at Misterton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Misterton towpath between top lock 63 at grid reference point SK 7728 9461 and bottom lock 64 at grid reference SK 7751 9465, a distance of 220 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From Monday, 4th January 2021 until Friday, 12th March 2021 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the towpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable Lock Gate replacement works and other maintenance around Misterton Locks 63 and 64, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the towpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
