



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(EDINGLEY FOOTPATH NO.11 AND FARNSFIELD FOOTPATH NO.20)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**EDINGLEY PUBLIC FOOTPATH 11 AND FARNSFIELD PUBLIC FOOTPATH 20**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2021**.

That Notice came into force on 18th January 2021.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: - proceed on foot,

in the following length of footpath at Edingley and Farnsfield in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Edingley Footpath No. 11 From Greaves Lane at SK 6514 5481 to the parish boundary, then continuing as **Farnsfield Footpath No. 20** to the junction with Farnsfield Footpath No. 28 at SK 6512 5520 and having a total length of approximately 390 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be Greaves Lane, Edingley Footpath No.12 and Farnsfield Footpath No.28 and vice versa

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 17th July 2021 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 8th February 2021 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety over an out of repair footbridge and a boggy/waterlogged/deep silted path and to allow repairs to be made.
