

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WINKBURN FOOTPATH NO.2) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>WINKBURN</u> <u>PUBLIC FOOTPATH 2</u>) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE <u>2021</u>.

That Notice came into force on 18th January 2021

The effects are that: -

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of footpath at Winkburn in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Winkburn Footpath No.2, at the Wink watercourse at Grid Reference SK 6970 6007.

<u>AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN</u> that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route.

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 17th July 2021 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 8th February 2021 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a collapsed culvert over the Wink watercourse.
