Thank you for your request for information relating to school places for LAC Children, Designated Safeguarding Leads in Schools and Pupil Premium Funding.

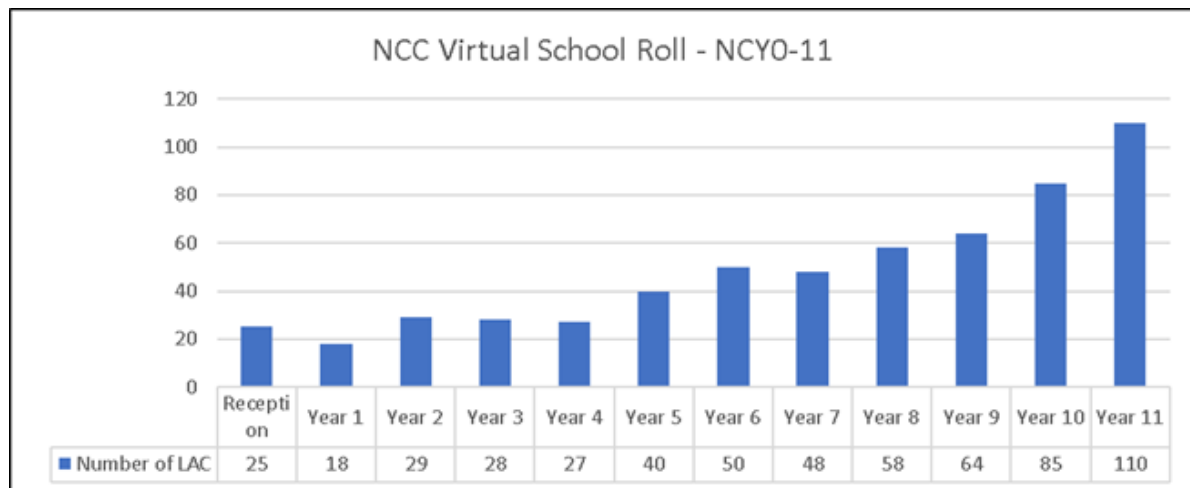
Please find below our responses to your specific questions:

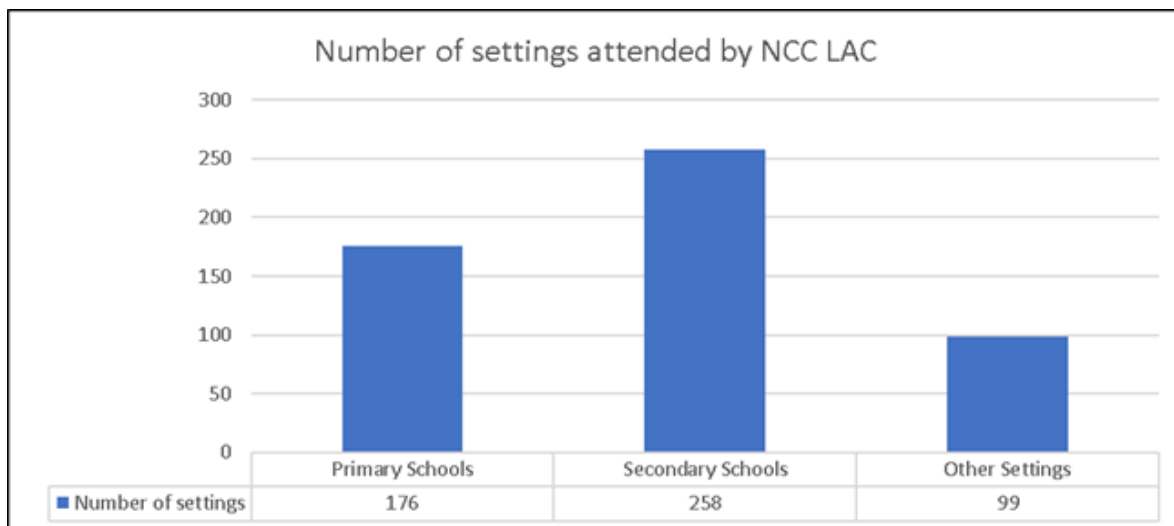
- 1) Can you please advise what schools in your Council have looked after children on roll for the academic year 19/20 & 20/21?**
- 2) How many looked after children are on roll in each school?**

We believe that to release the names of schools where LAC children are and have been on roll into the public domain would be likely to endanger the safety of some of these children, many of whom are in confidential placements and so consider this information to be exempt under Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act.

As some schools will have low numbers of LAC children on roll, we believe that if made publicly available, this information could enable some of these children to be identifiable and would therefore also consider that Section 40 would also apply to this information.

We are able to provide the following information about how many schools have LAC children on roll and the breakdown of the types of settings which we hope you will find useful





3) How much pupil premium plus funding was released to each school?

4) Contact names, email addresses & phone numbers for all school designated safeguarding leads for academic year 19/20 & 20/21

We do not hold and maintain this information. Due to the ongoing changes in staffing in schools and with regular conversion to academy status and changes within school management and Trusts, it is impossible to keep up to date data of current DSL's in all our county schools.

Each school/academy or college website should have a Child Protection Policy which must inform of the names of those in each school with DSL roles and responsibilities.

It is each school, academy or college's responsibility to inform of this, keep it up to date and publish it on their website for parents, carers and members of the school community and public to access.

I realise that this response is now being provided outside of the statutory timescale for provision of information requested under the Freedom of Information Act, and I apologise for this. I hope that the information provided remains relevant to you and that the delay has not caused you any difficulties.
