

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(FLEDBOROUGH FOOTPATH NO.1)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Fledborough Footpath No.1) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2026 (which came into force on 23rd March 2026 and was continued in force with a Continuation Order until 22nd September 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 22nd September 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Fledborough in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Fledborough Footpath No.1, the footbridge at grid reference SK 77172 71372, as shown on the accompanying plan,

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety following damage to the footbridge.
