



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD BRIDLEWAY NO.12)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Kirkby in Ashfield Bridleway No.12) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 8th August 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 7th February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 7th February 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall:-

- (a) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (b) cause any horse to proceed,
- (c) cause any animal to proceed

in the following length of Bridleway at Kirkby in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield-

Kirkby in Ashfield Bridleway No.12 (aka Mawkin Lane)

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction **the route will remain available to pedestrians** but there is no alternative route available for equestrians.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required due to protect the public and prevent further damage to the path due to erosion of bridleway.
